## A BILL

To eliminate unnecessary reporting requirements for unfunded programs under the Office of Justice Programs.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Reporting Efficiency  
5 Improvement Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. ELIMINATION OF REPORTS FOR UNFUNDED PRO-**  
2 **GRAMS UNDER THE OFFICE OF JUSTICE PRO-**  
3 **GRAMS.**

4 (a) DNA IDENTIFICATION GRANTS.—Section 2406  
5 of title I of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets  
6 Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 3796kk–5) is amended—

7 (1) by striking “(a) REPORTS TO ATTORNEY  
8 GENERAL.—”; and

9 (2) by striking subsection (b).

10 (b) POLICE CORPS PROGRAM.—

11 (1) REPEAL OF REPORT REQUIREMENT.—Sec-  
12 tion 200113 of the Police Corps Act (42 U.S.C.  
13 14102) is repealed.

14 (2) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—The Violent  
15 Crime Control and Law Enforcement Act of 1994 is  
16 amended by striking the item relating to section  
17 200113 in the table of contents contained in section  
18 2 of such Act.
