2 Congress finds the following:

3 (1) Hurricane Sandy inflicted catastrophic4 damage in the Northeastern United States.

5 (2) Houses of worship across the Northeast's
6 many faiths and denominations were among the pri7 vate nonprofit facilities that sustained damage.

8 (3) Churches, synagogues, mosques, temples,
9 and other houses of worship throughout communities
10 in New York, New Jersey, Connecticut, and else11 where play an essential role in the daily lives of the
12 communities.

(4) The Federal Emergency Management Agen(4) The Federal Emergency Management Agen(4) The Federal Emergency Management Agen(5) cy's (FEMA) public assistance program provides fi(6) nancial grants for the repair of various types of pri(7) vate nonprofit facilities.

17 (5) Among the types of nonprofits to which
18 FEMA provides such grants are those in which citi19 zens gather and engage in a variety of educational,
20 enrichment, and social activities. These activities are
21 essential to community building and occur in houses
22 of worship.

(6) Under the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5121
et seq.), FEMA's disaster relief program is a general
government program under which assistance is pro-

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1	vided in the wake of a natural disaster using criteria
2	that are neutral with regard to religion.
3	(7) Congress has previously enacted legislation
4	providing financial assistance to religious nonprofit
5	institutions, including houses of worship, on terms
6	equal to other eligible nonprofit institutions.
7	(8) Such legislation is consistent with recent
8	precedents of the Supreme Court of the United
9	States and legal opinions issued by the Office of
10	Legal Counsel of the Department of Justice.

(c) APPLICABILITY.—This section and the amendments made by this section shall apply to the provision
of assistance in response to a major disaster or emergency
declared on or after October 28, 2012.
