Mr. YOUNG of Florida introduced the following joint resolution; which was
referred to the Committee on _____

JOINT RESOLUTION

Making continuing appropriations for national intelligence
program operations for fiscal year 2014, and for other
purposes.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the following sums are hereby appropriated, out of
4 any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated,
5 for national intelligence program operations for fiscal year
6 2014, and for other purposes, namely:

7 SEC. 101. (a) Such amounts as may be necessary,
8 at a rate for operations as provided for in the Department

1 of Defense Appropriations Act, 2013 (division C of Public
2 Law 113–6), and under the authority and conditions pro-
3 vided in such Act, for continuing the following projects
4 or activities, conducted in fiscal year 2013, for which ap-
5 propriations, funds, or other authority were made avail-
6 able under such Act, as set forth under the heading “Na-
7 tional Intelligence Program” in the classified annex ac-
8 companying such Act:

9 (1) Payment of personnel compensation and
10 benefits for civilian employees whom the Director of
11 National Intelligence determines necessary to con-
12 tinue—

13 (A) producing finished intelligence for the
14 President or senior military or civilian officials
15 of the Federal government;

16 (B) collecting human, signals, or technical
17 intelligence;

18 (C) conducting a covert action (as defined
19 in section 503(e) of the National Security Act
20 of 1947 (50 U.S.C. 3093(e))), as directed by
21 the President;

22 (D) providing analytic support to critical
23 ongoing intelligence operations and military
24 combat operations; and

1 (E) maintaining the capability to provide
2 warnings of counterterrorism and international
3 terrorist threats to protect the life, safety, and
4 security of the United States interests.

5 (2) Payments under continuing contracts for
6 compensation of a contract employee or employees
7 whom the Director of National Intelligence deter-
8 mines necessary to support a function described in
9 any subparagraph of paragraph (1).

10 (b) The rate for operations provided by subsection (a)
11 for each project or activity shall be calculated to reflect
12 the full amount of any reduction required in fiscal year
13 2013 pursuant to—

14 (1) any provision of division G of the Consoli-
15 dated and Further Continuing Appropriations Act,
16 2013 (Public Law 113–6), including section 3004;
17 and

18 (2) the Presidential sequestration order dated
19 March 1, 2013, except as attributable to budget au-
20 thority made available by the Disaster Relief Appro-
21 priations Act, 2013 (Public Law 113–2).

22 SEC. 102. Appropriations made by section 101 shall
23 be available to the extent and in the manner that would
24 be provided by the pertinent appropriations Act.

1 SEC. 103. Unless otherwise provided for in this joint
2 resolution or in the applicable appropriations Act for fiscal
3 year 2014, appropriations and funds made available and
4 authority granted pursuant to this joint resolution shall
5 be available until whichever of the following first occurs:
6 (1) the enactment into law of an appropriation for any
7 project or activity provided for in this joint resolution; (2)
8 the enactment into law of the applicable appropriations
9 Act for fiscal year 2014 without any provision for such
10 project or activity; or (3) December 15, 2013.

11 SEC. 104. Expenditures made pursuant to this joint
12 resolution shall be charged to the applicable appropriation,
13 fund, or authorization whenever a bill in which such appli-
14 cable appropriation, fund, or authorization is contained is
15 enacted into law.

16 SEC. 105. This joint resolution shall be implemented
17 so that only the most limited funding action of that per-
18 mitted in the joint resolution shall be taken in order to
19 provide for continuation of projects and activities.

20 SEC. 106. It is the sense of Congress that this joint
21 resolution may also be referred to as the “Preserving Our
22 Intelligence Capabilities Act”.

23 This joint resolution may be cited as the “National
24 Intelligence Program Operations Continuing Appropria-
25 tions Resolution, 2014”.
