## **JOINT RESOLUTION**

Making appropriations for the salaries and related expenses of certain Federal employees during a lapse in funding authority for fiscal year 2014, and for other purposes.

- 1 Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives
- 2 of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 That the following sums are hereby appropriated, out of
- 4 any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated,
- 5 and out of applicable corporate or other revenues, receipts,
- 6 and funds, for the salaries and related expenses of certain
- 7 Federal employees for fiscal year 2014, and for other pur-
- 8 poses, namely:

- 1 Sec. 101. Such amounts as may be necessary for
- 2 paying salaries and related expenses of Federal employees
- 3 excepted from the provisions of the Antideficiency Act (31
- 4 U.S.C. 1341 et seq.) who work during the period begin-
- 5 ning October 1, 2013, and ending December 15, 2013,
- 6 when there is otherwise no funding authority for such sal-
- 7 aries and related expenses: Provided, That not later than
- 8 December 20, 2013, the Director of the Office of Manage-
- 9 ment and Budget shall provide to the Committees on Ap-
- 10 propriations of the House of Representatives and the Sen-
- 11 ate a report specifying the use of funds made available
- 12 to the Executive Branch by this joint resolution.
- 13 Sec. 102. Expenditures made pursuant to this joint
- 14 resolution shall be charged to the applicable appropriation,
- 15 fund, or authorization whenever a bill in which such appli-
- 16 cable appropriation, fund, or authorization is contained is
- 17 enacted into law.
- 18 Sec. 103. It is the sense of Congress that this joint
- 19 resolution may also be referred to as the "Federal Worker
- 20 Pay Fairness Act".
- 21 This joint resolution may be cited as the "Excepted
- 22 Employees' Pay Continuing Appropriations Resolution,
- 23 2014".
