## JOINT RESOLUTION

Making continuing appropriations for death gratuities and related survivor benefits for survivors of deceased military service members of the Department of Defense for fiscal year 2014, and for other purposes.

- 3 That the following sums are hereby appropriated, out of4 any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated,
- 5 for death gratuities and related benefits for survivors of

3 SEC. 101. (a) Such amounts as may be necessary, 4 at a rate for operations as provided for fiscal year 2013 in the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 2013 5 6 (division C of Public Law 113–6) and under the authority 7 and conditions provided in such Act, for "Operation and Maintenance" and "Military Personnel" accounts for con-8 9 tinuing the following projects and activities that are not otherwise specifically provided for in this joint resolution 10 or the Pay Our Military Act (Public Law 113–39), and 11 12 for which appropriations, funds, or other authority were 13 made available by the Department of Defense Appropria-14 tions Act, 2013:

(1) The payment of a death gratuity under sections 1475–1477 and 1489 of title 10, United States
Code.

18 (2) The payment or reimbursement for funeral
19 and burial expenses authorized under sections 1481
20 and 1482 of title 10, United States Code.

(3) The payment or reimbursement of authorized funeral travel and travel related to the dignified
transfer of remains and unit memorial services
under section 481f of title 37, United States Code.

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1 (4) The temporary continuation of a basic al-2 lowance of housing for dependents of members dying 3 on active duty, as authorized by section 403(1) of 4 title 37, United States Code. 5 (b) The rate for operations provided by subsection (a) for each program or activity shall be calculated to reflect 6 7 the full amount of any reduction required in fiscal year 8 2013 pursuant to— 9 (1) any provision of division G of the Consoli-10 dated and Further Continuing Appropriations Act, 11 2013 (Public Law 113-6), including section 3004; 12 and 13 (2) the Presidential sequestration order dated 14 March 1, 2013, except as attributable to budget au-15 thority made available by the Disaster Relief Appro-16 priations Act, 2013 (Public Law 113–2). 17 SEC. 102. Appropriations made by section 101 shall

17 SEC. 102. Appropriations made by section 101 shall18 be available to the extent and in the manner that would19 be provided by the pertinent appropriations Act.

SEC. 103. Unless otherwise provided for in this joint resolution or in the applicable appropriations Act for fiscal year 2014, appropriations and funds made available and authority granted pursuant to this joint resolution shall be available until whichever of the following first occurs: (1) the enactment into law of an appropriation for any 4

project or activity provided for in this joint resolution; (2)
 the enactment into law of the applicable appropriations
 Act for fiscal year 2014 without any provision for such
 project or activity; or (3) December 15, 2013.

5 SEC. 104. Expenditures made pursuant to this joint 6 resolution shall be charged to the applicable appropriation, 7 fund, or authorization whenever a bill in which such appli-8 cable appropriation, fund, or authorization is contained is 9 enacted into law.

10 SEC. 105. This joint resolution shall be implemented 11 so that only the most limited funding action of that per-12 mitted in the joint resolution shall be taken in order to 13 provide for continuation of projects and activities.

SEC. 106. It is the sense of Congress that this joint
resolution may also be referred to as the "Honoring the
Families of Fallen Soldiers Act".

17 This joint resolution may be cited as the "Depart-18 ment of Defense Survivor Benefits Continuing Appropria-19 tions Resolution, 2014".
