## A BILL

To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 25 South Oak Street in London, Ohio, as the “Lance Corporal Joshua B. McDaniels and Veterans Memorial Post Office Building”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. LONDON FALLEN VETERANS MEMORIAL POST**  
2 **OFFICE.**

3 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States  
4 Postal Service located at 25 South Oak Street in London,  
5 Ohio, shall be known and designated as the “London Fall-  
6 en Veterans Memorial Post Office”.

7 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-  
8 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United  
9 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall  
10 be deemed to be a reference to the “London Fallen Vet-  
11 erans Memorial Post Office”.

Amend the title so as to read: “A bill designate the  
facility of the United States Postal Service located at 25  
South Oak Street in London, Ohio, as the ‘London Fall-  
en Veterans Memorial Post Office’.”.
