To amend the National Trails System Act to direct the Secretary of the Interior to conduct a study on the feasibility of designating the Chief Standing Bear National Historic Trail, and for other purposes.

Mr. FORTENBERRY introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Natural Resources

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## A BILL

To amend the National Trails System Act to direct the Secretary of the Interior to conduct a study on the feasibility of designating the Chief Standing Bear National Historic Trail, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. CHIEF STANDING BEAR NATIONAL HISTORIC**  
2 **TRAIL FEASIBILITY STUDY.**

3 (a) AMENDMENT.—Section 5(c) of the National  
4 Trails System Act (16 U.S.C. 1244(c)) is amended by  
5 adding at the end the following:

6 “(\_\_\_\_) CHIEF STANDING BEAR NATIONAL HIS-  
7 TORIC TRAIL.—

8 “(A) IN GENERAL.—The Chief Standing  
9 Bear Trail, extending approximately 550 miles  
10 from Niobrara, Nebraska, to Ponca City, Okla-  
11 homa, which follows the route taken by Chief  
12 Standing Bear and the Ponca people during  
13 Federal Indian removal, and approximately 550  
14 miles from Ponca City, Oklahoma, through  
15 Omaha, Nebraska, to Niobrara, Nebraska,  
16 which follows the return route taken by Chief  
17 Standing Bear and the Ponca people, as gen-  
18 erally depicted on the map entitled ‘Chief  
19 Standing Bear National Historic Trail Feasi-  
20 bility Study’, numbered 903/125,630, and dated  
21 November 2014.

22 “(B) AVAILABILITY OF MAP.—The map  
23 described in subparagraph (A) shall be on file  
24 and available for public inspection in the appro-  
25 priate offices of the Department of the Interior.

1           “(C) COMPONENTS.—The feasibility study  
2           conducted pursuant to subparagraph (A) shall  
3           include a determination on whether the Chief  
4           Standing Bear Trail meets the criteria in sub-  
5           section (b) of for designation as a national his-  
6           toric trail.”.

7           (b) TIMELINE.—The feasibility study authorized by  
8           the amendment in subsection (a) shall be completed not  
9           later than one year after the date of the enactment of this  
10          Act.
