A BILL

To reauthorize the Young Women’s Breast Health Education
and Awareness Requires Learning Young Act of 2009.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “EARLY Act Reauthor-
5 ization of 2014”.

1 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF THE YOUNG WOMEN'S**
2 **BREAST HEALTH EDUCATION AND AWARE-**
3 **NESS REQUIRES LEARNING YOUNG ACT OF**
4 **2009.**

5 Section 399NN(h) of the Public Health Service Act
6 (42 U.S.C. 280m(h)) is amended by striking “\$9,000,000
7 for each of the fiscal years 2010 through 2014” and in-
8 serting “\$4,900,000 for each of fiscal years 2015 through
9 2019”.

10 **SEC. 3. GAO REPORT ON HHS ACTIVITIES TO PROVIDE**
11 **BREAST CANCER EDUCATION.**

12 Not later than 2 years after the date of enactment
13 of this Act, the Comptroller General of the United States
14 shall submit to the appropriate committees of the Con-
15 gress a report—

16 (1) listing and detailing the activities of the De-
17 partment of Health and Human Services that pro-
18 vide or support breast cancer education described in
19 subsection (a), (b), (c), or (d) of section 399NN of
20 the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 280m);
21 and

22 (2) identifying any such activities that are du-
23 plicative with each other or with other Federal
24 breast cancer education efforts.
