Mr. HUIZENGA of Michigan (for himself and Mrs. CAROLYN B. MALONEY of New York) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Financial Services

A BILL

To amend design and content requirements for certain gold
and silver coins, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Bullion and Collectible
5 Coin Production Efficiency and Cost Savings Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS.**

7 Title 31, United States Code, is amended—

8 (1) in section 5112—

1 (A) in subsection (q)—

2 (i) by striking paragraphs (3) and (8);

3 and

4 (ii) by redesignating paragraphs (4),

5 (5), (6), and (7) as paragraphs (3), (4),

6 (5), and (6), respectively;

7 (B) in subsection (t)(6)(B), by striking

8 “90 percent silver and 10 percent copper” and

9 inserting “not less than 90 percent silver”; and

10 (C) in subsection (v)—

11 (i) in paragraph (1), by striking

12 “Subject to” and all that follows through

13 “the Secretary shall” and inserting “The

14 Secretary shall”;

15 (ii) in paragraph (2)(A), by striking

16 “The Secretary” and inserting “To the

17 greatest extent possible, the Secretary”;

18 (iii) in paragraph (5), by inserting

19 after “may issue” the following: “collect-

20 ible versions of”; and

21 (iv) by striking paragraph (8); and

22 (2) in section 5132(a)(2)(B)(i), by striking “90

23 percent silver and 10 percent copper” and inserting

24 “not less than 90 percent silver”.

3 Proof and uncirculated versions of coins issued by the
4 Secretary of the Treasury pursuant to subsection (e) of
5 section 5112 of title 31, United States Code, during cal-
6 endar year 2016 shall have a smooth edge incused with
7 a designation that notes the 30th anniversary of the first
8 issue of coins under such subsection.
