A BILL

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Securing Fairness in
5 Regulatory Timing Act of 2015”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENDING THE ANNUAL COMMENT PERIOD FOR**
2 **PAYMENT RATES UNDER MEDICARE ADVAN-**
3 **TAGE.**

4 Section 1853(b)(2) of the Social Security Act (42
5 U.S.C. 1395w-23(b)(2)) is amended—

6 (1) by inserting “(or, in 2017 and each subse-
7 quent year, at least 60 days)” after “45 days”; and

8 (2) by inserting “(in 2017 and each subsequent
9 year, of no less than 30 days)” after “opportunity”.
