the Constitution and laws of the United States.

SEC. 2. The Speaker shall notify the House of Rep resentatives of a decision to file one or more briefs as ami cus curiae pursuant to this resolution.

The Office of General Counsel of the House 5 of Representatives, at the direction of the Speaker, shall 6 represent the House in connection with the filing of any 7 brief as amicus curiae pursuant to this resolution, includ-8 ing supervision of any outside counsel providing services 9 to the Speaker on a pro bono basis for such purpose.
