A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to permit the disclosure of certain tax return information for the purpose of missing or exploited children investigations.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4	This Act may be cited as the "Recovering Missing
5	Children Act".
6	SEC. 2. DISCLOSURE OF CERTAIN RETURN INFORMATION
7	RELATING TO MISSING OR EXPLOITED CHIL-
8	DREN INVESTIGATIONS.
9	(a) In General.—Section 6103(i)(1) of the Internal
10	Revenue Code of 1986 is amended—
11	(1) by inserting "or pertaining to the case of a
12	missing or exploited child," after "may be a party,"
13	$in\ subparagraph\ (A)(i),$
14	(2) by inserting "or to such a case of a missing
15	or exploited child," after "may be a party," in sub-
16	paragraph (A)(iii), and
17	(3) by inserting "(or any criminal investigation
18	or proceeding, in the case of a matter relating to a
19	missing or exploited child)" after "concerning such
20	act" in subparagraph (B)(iii).
21	(b) Disclosure to State and Local Law En-
22	FORCEMENT AGENCIES.—
23	(1) In General.—Section 6103(i)(1) of the In-
24	ternal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by adding
25	at the end the following new subparagraph:

1	"(C) Disclosure to state and local
2	LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES IN THE CASE OF
3	MATTERS PERTAINING TO A MISSING OR EX-
4	PLOITED CHILD.—
5	"(i) In general.—In the case of an
6	investigation pertaining to a missing or ex-
7	ploited child, the head of any Federal agen-
8	cy, or his designee, may disclose any return
9	or return information obtained under sub-
10	paragraph (A) to officers and employees of
11	any State or local law enforcement agency,
12	but only if—
13	"(I) such State or local law en-
14	forcement agency is part of a team
15	with the Federal agency in such inves-
16	tigation, and
17	"(II) such information is disclosed
18	only to such officers and employees
19	who are personally and directly en-
20	gaged in such investigation.
21	"(ii) Limitation on use of informa-
22	TION.—Information disclosed under this
23	subparagraph shall be solely for the use of
24	such officers and employees in locating the
25	missing child, in a grand jury proceeding,

1	or in any preparation for, or investigation
2	which may result in, a judicial or adminis-
3	$trative\ proceeding.$
4	"(iii) Missing Child.—For purposes
5	of this subparagraph, the term 'missing
6	child' shall have the meaning given such
7	term by section 403 of the Missing Chil-
8	dren's Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5772).
9	"(iv) Exploited child.—For pur-
10	poses of this subparagraph, the term 'ex-
11	ploited child' means a minor with respect to
12	whom there is reason to believe that a speci-
13	fied offense against a minor (as defined by
14	section 111(7) of the Sex Offender Registra-
15	tion and Notification Act (42 U.S.C.
16	16911(7))) has or is occurring.".
17	(2) Conforming amendments.—
18	(A) Section $6103(a)(2)$ of such Code is
19	amended by striking "subsection $(i)(7)(A)$ " and
20	inserting "subsection $(i)(1)(C)$ or $(7)(A)$ ".
21	(B) Section $6103(p)(4)$ of such Code is
22	amended by striking " $(i)(3)(B)(i)$ " in the matter
23	preceding subparagraph (A) and inserting
24	(i)(1)(C), (3)(B)(i),.

1	(C) Section $7213(a)(2)$ of such Code is
2	amended by striking " $(i)(3)(B)(i)$ " and inserting
3	(i)(1)(C), (3)(B)(i),.
4	(c) Effective Date.—The amendments made by this
5	section shall apply to disclosures made after the date of the
6	enactment of this Act.
