A BILL

To amend the Foreign Narcotics Kingpin Designation Act to protect classified information in Federal court challenges.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4	This Act may be cited as the "Kingpin Designation
5	Improvement Act of 2016".
6	SEC. 2. PROTECTION OF CLASSIFIED INFORMATION IN
7	FEDERAL COURT CHALLENGES RELATING TO
8	DESIGNATIONS UNDER THE NARCOTICS
9	KINGPIN DESIGNATION ACT.
10	Section 804 of the Foreign Narcotics Kingpin Des-
11	ignation Act (21 U.S.C. 1903) is amended by adding at
12	the end the following:
13	"(i) Protection of Classified Information in
14	FEDERAL COURT CHALLENGES RELATING TO DESIGNA-
15	TIONS.—In any judicial review of a determination made
16	under this section, if the determination was based on clas-
17	sified information (as defined in section 1(a) of the Classi-
18	fied Information Procedures Act) such information may
19	be submitted to the reviewing court ex parte and in cam-
20	era. This subsection does not confer or imply any right

21 to judicial review.".
