## A BILL

To extend the deadline for commencement of construction of certain hydroelectric projects. 3

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the "J. Bennett Johnston Wa5 terway Hydropower Extension Act of 2017".

## 6 SEC. 2. EXTENSION.

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding the time period 8 specified in section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 9 806) that would otherwise apply to Federal Energy Requ-10 latory Commission project numbers 12756, 12757, and 12758, the Commission may, at the request of the licensee 11 12 for the applicable project, and after reasonable notice, in 13 accordance with the good faith, due diligence, and public interest requirements of that section and the Commission's 14 procedures under that section, extend the time period dur-15 ing which such licensee is required to commence the con-16 struction of its applicable project for up to 3 consecutive 17 2-year periods from the date of the expiration of any exten-18 sion issued by the Commission under that section for such 19 20 project.

(b) OBLIGATION FOR PAYMENT OF ANNUAL
CHARGES.—Any obligation of a licensee for a project described in subsection (a) for the payment of annual charges
under section 10(e) of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C.

803(e)) shall commence when the construction of the project
 commences.

3 (c) REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSE; EFFECTIVE DATE
4 FOR EXTENSION.—

(1) REINSTATEMENT.—If the time period required for commencement of construction of a project
described in subsection (a) has expired prior to the
date of the enactment of this Act, the Commission
may reinstate the license for such project, effective as
of the date of the expiration of the license.

(2) EFFECTIVE DATE FOR EXTENSION.—If the
Commission reinstates a license under paragraph (1)
for a project, the first extension authorized under subsection (a) with respect to such project shall take effect
on the effective date of such reinstatement under
paragraph (1).
