A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to establish a structure for visitor services on the Arlington Ridge tract, in the area of the U.S. Marine Corps War Memorial, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DEFINITION.**

4 In this Act, the term “Arlington Ridge tract” means
5 the parcel of Federal land located in Arlington County,
6 Virginia, known as the Nevius Tract and transferred to
7 the Department of the Interior in 1953, that is bounded
8 generally by—

9 (1) Arlington Boulevard (United States Route
10 50) to the north;

11 (2) Jefferson Davis Highway (Virginia Route
12 110) to the east;

13 (3) Marshall Drive to the south; and

14 (4) North Meade Street to the west.

15 **SEC. 2. ESTABLISHMENT OF A VISITOR SERVICES FACILITY**

16 **ON THE ARLINGTON RIDGE TRACT.**

17 Notwithstanding section 2863(g) of Public Law 107–
18 107, the Secretary of the Interior is authorized to con-
19 struct a structure for visitor services to include a public
20 restroom facility on the Arlington Ridge tract in the area
21 of the U.S. Marine Corps War Memorial.
