A BILL

To expand the Department of Veterans Affairs medical professionals who may qualify to perform physical examinations on eligible veterans and issue medical certificates required for operation of a commercial motor vehicle, and for other purposes.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4	This Act may be cited as the "Veterans Expanded
5	Trucking Opportunities Act of 2017".
6	SEC. 2. MEDICAL CERTIFICATE FOR VETERANS OPERATING
7	COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLES.
8	(a) Qualified Examiners.—Section 5403(d)(2) of
9	the FAST Act (49 U.S.C. 31149 note; 129 Stat. 1548) is
10	amended to read as follows:
11	"(2) Qualified examiner.—The term 'qualified
12	examiner' means an individual who—
13	"(A) is employed in the Department of Vet-
14	erans Affairs as an advanced practice nurse,
15	doctor of chiropractic, doctor of medicine, doctor
16	of osteopathy, physician assistant, or other med-
17	ical professional;
18	"(B) is licensed, certified, or registered in a
19	State to perform physical examinations;
20	"(C) is familiar with the standards for, and
21	physical requirements of, an operator required to
22	be medically certified under section 31149 of title
23	49, United States Code: and

1	"(D) has never, with respect to such section,
2	been found to have acted fraudulently, including
3	by fraudulently awarding a medical certificate.".
4	(b) Conforming Amendments.—Section 5403 of the
5	FAST Act (49 U.S.C. 31149 note; 129 Stat. 1548) is
6	amended—
7	(1) in subsection (a)—
8	(A) by striking "physician-approved vet-
9	eran operator," and inserting "veteran operator
10	approved by a qualified examiner,"; and
11	(B) by striking "qualified physician" and
12	inserting "qualified examiner";
13	(2) in subsection (b)(1)—
14	(A) by striking "the physician" and insert-
15	ing "the examiner"; and
16	(B) by striking "qualified physician" and
17	inserting "qualified examiner";
18	(3) in subsection (c)—
19	(A) by striking "qualified physicians" and
20	inserting "qualified examiners"; and
21	(B) by striking "such physicians" and in-
22	serting "such examiners"; and
23	(4) in subsection $(d)(1)$ —
24	(A) in the paragraph heading by striking
25	"Physician-approved veteran operator"

1	and inserting "VETERAN OPERATOR APPROVED
2	BY A QUALIFIED EXAMINER"; and
3	(B) by striking "physician-approved vet-
4	eran operator" and inserting "veteran operator
5	approved by a qualified examiner".
6	(c) Rulemaking.—The amendments made by this sec-
7	tion shall be incorporated into any rulemaking proceeding
8	related to section 5403 of the FAST Act (49 U.S.C. 31149
9	note; 129 Stat. 1548) that is being conducted as of the date
10	of enactment of this Act.
