A BILL

To provide for the establishment of a national memorial and national monument to commemorate those killed by the collapse of the Saint Francis Dam on March 12, 1928, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Saint Francis Dam
5 Disaster National Memorial Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. FINDINGS.**

7 Congress finds the following:

8 (1) On March 12, 1928, the Saint Francis Dam
9 located in the northern portion of Los Angeles Coun-
10 ty, California, breached, resulting in a devastating
11 flood that caused the death of approximately 425 in-
12 dividuals.

13 (2) The residents of Santa Clarita Valley, San
14 Francisquito Canyon, Castaic Junction, Santa Clara
15 River Valley, Piru, Fillmore, Bardsdale, Saticoy, and
16 Santa Paula were directly impacted and suffered
17 greatly from the worst flood in the history of the
18 State of California.

19 (3) The disaster resulted in a tremendous loss
20 of human life, property, and the livelihood of local
21 residents, and was surpassed in the level of destruc-
22 tion in the 20th century only by the great San Fran-
23 cisco earthquake of 1906.

1 (4) The collapse of the dam may represent
2 America's worst civil engineering failure in the 20th
3 century.

4 (5) The site of the disaster is subject to the
5 theft of historic artifacts, graffiti, and other van-
6 dalism.

7 (6) It is right to pay homage to the citizens
8 who were killed, injured, or dislocated due to the
9 flood, and to educate the public about this important
10 historical event.

11 (7) It is appropriate that the site of the Saint
12 Francis Dam and surrounding areas be specially
13 designated and protected to commemorate this trag-
14 ic event.

15 **SEC. 3. SAINT FRANCIS DAM DISASTER NATIONAL MEMO-**
16 **RIAL.**

17 (a) **ESTABLISHMENT.**—The Secretary is authorized
18 to establish a memorial at the Saint Francis Dam site in
19 the County of Los Angeles, California, for the purpose of
20 honoring the victims of the Saint Francis Dam disaster
21 of March 12, 1928.

22 (b) **REQUIREMENTS.**—The Memorial shall be—

23 (1) known as the Saint Francis Dam Disaster
24 National Memorial; and

25 (2) managed by the Forest Service.

1 (c) DONATIONS.—The Secretary is authorized to ac-
2 cept, hold, administer, invest, and spend any gift, devise,
3 or bequest of real or personal property made to the Sec-
4 retary for purposes of developing, designing, constructing,
5 and managing the Memorial.

6 **SEC. 4. RECOMMENDATIONS FOR MEMORIAL.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 3 years after the
8 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall sub-
9 mit to Congress recommendations regarding—

10 (1) the planning, design, construction, and
11 long-term management of the Memorial;

12 (2) the proposed boundaries of the Memorial;

13 (3) a visitor center and educational facilities at
14 the Memorial; and

15 (4) ensuring public access to the Memorial.

16 (b) CONSULTATION.—In preparing the recommenda-
17 tions required under subsection (a), the Secretary shall
18 consult with—

19 (1) appropriate Federal agencies;

20 (2) State, tribal, and local governments, includ-
21 ing the Santa Clarita City Council; and

22 (3) the public.

1 **SEC. 5. ESTABLISHMENT OF SAINT FRANCIS DAM DISASTER**
2 **NATIONAL MONUMENT.**

3 (a) ESTABLISHMENT.—There is established as a na-
4 tional monument in the State, certain National Forest
5 System land administered by the Secretary in the County
6 of Los Angeles comprising approximately 440 acres, as
7 generally depicted on the map entitled “Proposed Saint
8 Francis Dam Disaster National Monument”, created on
9 June 14, 2016, to be known as the Saint Francis Dam
10 Disaster National Monument.

11 (b) PURPOSE.—The purpose of the Monument is to
12 conserve and enhance for the benefit and enjoyment of the
13 public the cultural, archaeological, historical, watershed,
14 educational, and recreational resources and values of the
15 Monument.

16 **SEC. 6. DUTIES OF THE SECRETARY WITH RESPECT TO**
17 **MONUMENT.**

18 (a) MANAGEMENT PLAN.—

19 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 4 years after
20 the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary
21 shall develop a management plan for the Monument.

22 (2) CONSULTATION.—The management plan
23 shall be developed in consultation with—

24 (A) appropriate Federal agencies;

25 (B) State, tribal, and local governments;

26 and

1 (C) the public.

2 (3) CONSIDERATIONS.—In developing and im-
3 plementing the management plan, the Secretary
4 shall, with respect to methods of protecting and pro-
5 viding access to the Monument, consider the rec-
6 ommendations of the Saint Francis Disaster Na-
7 tional Memorial Foundation, the Santa Clarita Val-
8 ley Historical Society, and the Community Hiking
9 Club of Santa Clarita.

10 (b) MANAGEMENT.—The Secretary shall manage the
11 Monument—

12 (1) in a manner that conserves and enhances
13 the cultural and historic resources of the Monument;
14 and

15 (2) in accordance with—

16 (A) the Forest and Rangeland Renewable
17 Resources Planning Act of 1974 (16 U.S.C.
18 1600 et seq.) and the laws generally applicable
19 to the National Forest System;

20 (B) this Act; and

21 (C) any other applicable laws.

22 (c) USES.—

23 (1) USE OF MOTORIZED VEHICLES.—The use of
24 motorized vehicles within the Monument may be per-
25 mitted only—

1 (A) on roads designated for use by motor-
2 ized vehicles in the management plan required
3 under subsection (a);

4 (B) for administrative purposes; or

5 (C) for emergency responses.

6 (2) GRAZING.—The Secretary shall permit
7 grazing within the Monument, where established be-
8 fore the date of the enactment of this Act—

9 (A) subject to all applicable laws (including
10 regulations and Executive orders); and

11 (B) consistent with the purpose described
12 in section 5(b).

13 **SEC. 7. CLARIFICATION ON FUNDING.**

14 No additional funds are authorized to carry out the
15 requirements of this Act. Such requirements shall be car-
16 ried out using amounts otherwise authorized.

17 **SEC. 8. DEFINITIONS.**

18 In this Act:

19 (1) MEMORIAL.—The term “Memorial” means
20 the Saint Frances Dam Disaster National Memorial
21 authorized under section 3(a).

22 (2) MONUMENT.—The term “Monument”
23 means the Saint Francis Dam Disaster National
24 Monument established under section 5(a).

1 (3) STATE.—The term “State” means the State
2 of California.

3 (4) SECRETARY.—The term “Secretary” means
4 the Secretary of Agriculture.
