## **A BILL**

To direct the Secretary of Energy to review and update a report on the energy and environmental benefits of the re-refining of used lubricating oil.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ENERGY SAVINGS FROM LUBRICATING OIL.**

4        Not later than one year after the date of enactment  
5 of this Act, the Secretary of Energy, in cooperation with  
6 the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agen-  
7 cy and the Director of the Office of Management and  
8 Budget, shall—

9            (1) review and update the report prepared pur-  
10        suant to section 1838 of the Energy Policy Act of  
11        2005;

12            (2) after consultation with relevant Federal,  
13        State, and local agencies and affected industry and  
14        stakeholder groups, update data that was used in  
15        preparing that report; and

16            (3) prepare and submit to Congress a coordi-  
17        nated Federal strategy to increase the beneficial  
18        reuse of used lubricating oil, that—

19            (A) is consistent with national policy as es-  
20        tablished pursuant to section 2 of the Used Oil  
21        Recycling Act of 1980 (Public Law 96–463);  
22        and

23            (B) addresses measures needed to—

24            (i) increase the responsible collection  
25        of used oil;

1                   (ii) disseminate public information  
2                   concerning sustainable reuse options for  
3                   used oil; and

4                   (iii) promote sustainable reuse of used  
5                   oil by Federal agencies, recipients of Fed-  
6                   eral grant funds, entities contracting with  
7                   the Federal Government, and the general  
8                   public.
