Mr. CARSON of Indiana (for himself, Mr. BANKS of Indiana, Mrs. BROOKS of Indiana, Mr. BUCSHON, Mr. HOLLINGSWORTH, Mr. MESSER, Mr. ROKITA, Mr. VISCLOSKY, Mrs. WALORSKI, Mr. KENNEDY, and Mr. LEWIS of Georgia) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Natural Resources

A BILL

To establish the Kennedy–King National Historic Site in
the State of Indiana, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Kennedy–King Na-
5 tional Commemorative Site Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.**

7 In this Act:

1 (1) SECRETARY.—The term “Secretary” means
2 the Secretary of the Interior.

3 (2) SITE.—The term “Site” means the Ken-
4 neddy-King National Commemorative Site as des-
5 ignated by section 3(a).

6 (3) STATE.—The term “State” means the State
7 of Indiana.

8 **SEC. 3. NATIONAL COMMEMORATIVE SITE.**

9 (a) DESIGNATION.—The Landmark for Peace Memo-
10 rial in Martin Luther King, Jr. Park in Indianapolis, in
11 the State, is hereby designated as the Kennedy-King Na-
12 tional Commemorative Site.

13 (b) AFRICAN AMERICAN CIVIL RIGHTS NETWORK.—
14 The Site shall be part of the African American Civil
15 Rights Network established under Public Law 115–104.

16 (c) ADMINISTRATION.—

17 (1) COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS.—The Sec-
18 retary may enter into cooperative agreements with
19 appropriate public or private entities for interpreta-
20 tive and educational purposes related to the Site.

21 (2) EFFECT OF DESIGNATION.—The Site shall
22 not be a unit of the National Park System.

23 (3) LIMITATIONS.—Nothing in this Act—

24 (A) authorizes the Secretary to interfere
25 with the rights of any person with respect to

1 private property or any local zoning ordinance
2 or land use plan of the State or any political
3 subdivision thereof; or

4 (B) authorizes the Secretary to acquire
5 land or interests in land through condemnation
6 or otherwise.

7 (d) SPECIAL RESOURCE STUDY.—The Secretary
8 shall conduct a special resource study of the Site to evalu-
9 ate the national significance of the Site and determine the
10 suitability and feasibility of designating the Site as a unit
11 of the National Park System. The Secretary shall also
12 consider other alternatives for preservation, protection,
13 and interpretation of the Site by Federal, State, or local
14 government entities, or private and non-profit groups. The
15 study shall be conducted in accordance with section
16 100507 of title 54, United States Code. Not later than
17 three years after the date on which funds are made avail-
18 able to conduct the study, the Secretary shall submit a
19 report to Congress that describes the results of the study
20 and any recommendations of the Secretary.

Amend the title so as to read: “A Bill to establish the Kennedy-King National Commemorative Site in the State of Indiana, and for other purposes.”.
