# SEC. 2. NATIONAL URBAN SECURITY TECHNOLOGY LAB ORATORY. (a) IN GENERAL.—Title III of the Homeland Secu rity Act of 2002 is amended—

5 (1) by redesignating the second section 319 (re6 lating to EMP and GMD mitigation research and
7 development) as section 320; and

8 (2) by inserting after section 320, as so redesig-9 nated, the following new section:

10"SEC. 321. NATIONAL URBAN SECURITY TECHNOLOGY LAB-11ORATORY.

"(a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary, acting through 12 the Under Secretary for Science and Technology, shall 13 14 designate the laboratory described in subsection (b) as an 15 additional laboratory pursuant to the authority under sec-16 tion 308(c)(2). Such laboratory shall be used to test and 17 evaluate emerging technologies and conduct research and development to assist emergency response providers in 18 19 preparing for, and protecting against, threats of terrorism. 20 "(b) LABORATORY DESCRIBED.—The laboratory de-
