## A BILL

To amend the Financial Stability Act of 2010 to provide a criminal penalty for unauthorized disclosures of certain individually identifiable information by officers or employees of a Federal department or agency.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Prevention of Private  
5 Information Dissemination Act of 2017”.

1 **SEC. 2. CRIMINAL PENALTY FOR UNAUTHORIZED DISCLO-**  
2 **SURES.**

3 Section 165 of the Financial Stability Act of 2010  
4 (12 U.S.C. 5365) is amended by adding at the end the  
5 following:

6 “(1) CRIMINAL PENALTY FOR UNAUTHORIZED DIS-  
7 CLOSURES.—Section 552a(i)(1) of title 5, United States  
8 Code, shall apply to a determination made under sub-  
9 section (d) or (i) based on individually identifiable infor-  
10 mation submitted pursuant to the requirements of this  
11 section to the same extent as such section 552a(i)(1) ap-  
12 plies to agency records which contain individually identifi-  
13 able information the disclosure of which is prohibited by  
14 such section 552a or by rules or regulations established  
15 thereunder.”.

Amend the title so as to read: “A bill to amend the  
Financial Stability Act of 2010 to provide a criminal pen-  
alty for unauthorized disclosures by officers or employees  
of a Federal agency of certain living will and stress test  
determinations.”.
