The portion of 9 the divided question comprising title I shall be debatable 10 for 30 minutes, equally divided and controlled by the Majority Leader and the Minority Leader or their respective 11 designees. The portion of the divided question comprising 12 13 title II shall be debatable for one hour, equally divided and controlled by the Majority Leader and the Minority 14 15 Leader or their respective designees. The portion of the divided question comprising title III shall be debatable for 16 17 one hour, equally divided and controlled by the Majority Leader and the Minority Leader or their respective des-18 ignees. Each portion of the divided question shall be dis-19 20 posed of in the order stated.

SEC. 3. During consideration of House Resolution 6
pursuant to this resolution, notwithstanding the operation
of the previous question, the Chair may postpone further
consideration of the resolution to a time designated by the
Speaker.

Upon adoption of this resolution it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 21) mak-2 3 ing appropriations for the fiscal year ending September 4 30, 2019, and for other purposes. All points of order 5 against consideration of the bill are waived. The bill shall be considered as read. All points of order against provi-6 7 sions in the bill are waived. The previous question shall 8 be considered as ordered on the bill and on any amend-9 ment thereto to final passage without intervening motion 10 except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and controlled by Representative Lowey of New York and Rep-11 resentative Granger of Texas or their respective designees; 12 13 and (2) one motion to recommit.

14 SEC. 5. Upon adoption of this resolution it shall be 15 in order to consider in the House the joint resolution (H.J. Res. 1) making further continuing appropriations for the 16 Department of Homeland Security for fiscal year 2019, 17 18 and for other purposes. All points of order against consid-19 eration of the joint resolution are waived. The joint resolution shall be considered as read. All points of order against 20 21 provisions in the joint resolution are waived. The previous 22 question shall be considered as ordered on the joint resolu-23 tion and on any amendment thereto to final passage with-24 out intervening motion except: (1) 30 minutes of debate 25 equally divided and controlled by Representative Lowey of

- 1 New York and Representative Granger of Texas or their
- 2 respective designees; and (2) one motion to recommit.
