Mr. MCGOVERN submitted the following resolution

# RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the resolution (H. Res. 6) adopting the Rules of the House of Representatives for the One Hundred Sixteenth Congress; providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 21) making appropriations for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2019, and for other purposes; and providing for consideration of the joint resolution (H.J. Res. 1) making further continuing appropriations for the Department of Homeland Security for fiscal year 2019, and for other purposes.

- 1       *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
- 2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the resolution
- 3 (H. Res. 6) adopting the Rules of the House of Represent-

1 atives for the One Hundred Sixteenth Congress. The reso-  
2 lution shall be considered as read. The previous question  
3 shall be considered as ordered on the resolution to its  
4 adoption without intervening motion or demand for divi-  
5 sion of the question except as specified in sections 2 and  
6 3 of this resolution.

7       SEC. 2. The question of adopting the resolution shall  
8 be divided among each of its three titles. The portion of  
9 the divided question comprising title I shall be debatable  
10 for 30 minutes, equally divided and controlled by the Ma-  
11 jority Leader and the Minority Leader or their respective  
12 designees. The portion of the divided question comprising  
13 title II shall be debatable for one hour, equally divided  
14 and controlled by the Majority Leader and the Minority  
15 Leader or their respective designees. The portion of the  
16 divided question comprising title III shall be debatable for  
17 one hour, equally divided and controlled by the Majority  
18 Leader and the Minority Leader or their respective des-  
19 ignees. Each portion of the divided question shall be dis-  
20 posed of in the order stated.

21       SEC. 3. During consideration of House Resolution 6  
22 pursuant to this resolution, notwithstanding the operation  
23 of the previous question, the Chair may postpone further  
24 consideration of the resolution to a time designated by the  
25 Speaker.

1           SEC. 4. Upon adoption of this resolution it shall be  
2 in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 21) mak-  
3 ing appropriations for the fiscal year ending September  
4 30, 2019, and for other purposes. All points of order  
5 against consideration of the bill are waived. The bill shall  
6 be considered as read. All points of order against provi-  
7 sions in the bill are waived. The previous question shall  
8 be considered as ordered on the bill and on any amend-  
9 ment thereto to final passage without intervening motion  
10 except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and con-  
11 trolled by Representative Lowey of New York and Rep-  
12 resentative Granger of Texas or their respective designees;  
13 and (2) one motion to recommit.

14           SEC. 5. Upon adoption of this resolution it shall be  
15 in order to consider in the House the joint resolution (H.J.  
16 Res. 1) making further continuing appropriations for the  
17 Department of Homeland Security for fiscal year 2019,  
18 and for other purposes. All points of order against consid-  
19 eration of the joint resolution are waived. The joint resolu-  
20 tion shall be considered as read. All points of order against  
21 provisions in the joint resolution are waived. The previous  
22 question shall be considered as ordered on the joint resolu-  
23 tion and on any amendment thereto to final passage with-  
24 out intervening motion except: (1) 30 minutes of debate  
25 equally divided and controlled by Representative Lowey of

- 1 New York and Representative Granger of Texas or their
- 2 respective designees; and (2) one motion to recommit.
