### A BILL

To amend title 44, United States Code, to modernize the Federal Register, and for other purposes.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

#### **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Federal Register Mod-

5 ernization Act".

#### 6 SEC. 2. FEDERAL REGISTER MODERNIZATION.

7 (a) REFERENCES TO PRINTING.—Chapter 15 of title

8 44, United States Code, is amended—

9 (1) in section 1502—

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1	(A) in the heading, by striking " <b>print-</b>
2	<b>ing</b> " and inserting " <b>publishing</b> "; and
3	(B) by striking "printing and distribution"
4	and inserting "publishing";
5	(2) in section 1507 is amended—
6	(A) by striking "the duplicate originals or
7	certified copies of the document have" and in-
8	serting "the document has"; and
9	(B) in paragraph (2), by striking "print-
10	ed" and inserting "published"; and
11	(3) in section 1509, in subsections $(a)$ and $(b)$
12	of, by striking "printing, reprinting, wrapping, bind-
13	ing, and distributing" and inserting "publishing",
14	each place it appears.
15	(b) Publish Defined.—Section 1501 of title 44,
16	United States Code, is amended—
17	(1) by striking "; and" at the end of the defini-
18	tion for "person" and inserting a semicolon; and
19	(2) by inserting after the definition for "per-
20	son" the following:
21	"'publish' means to circulate for sale or dis-
22	tribution to the public; and".
23	(c) FILING DOCUMENTS WITH OFFICE AMEND-
24	MENT.—Section 1503 of title 44, United States Code, is
25	amended to read as follows:

# 1 "§ 1503. Filing documents with Office; notation of time; public inspection; transmission for publishing

"The original document required or authorized to be 4 5 published by section 1505 of this title shall be filed with the Office of the Federal Register for publication at times 6 7 established by the Administrative Committee of the Federal Register by regulation. The Archivist of the United 8 9 States shall cause to be noted on the original of each docu-10 ment the day and hour of filing. Upon filing, the document 11 shall be immediately available for public inspection in the 12 Office. The original shall be retained by the National Ar-13 chives and Records Administration and shall be available for inspection under regulations prescribed by the Archi-14 15 vist, unless such original is disposed of in accordance with 16 disposal schedules submitted by the Administrative Committee and authorized by the Archivist pursuant to regula-17 18 tions issued under chapter 33 of this title; however, origi-19 nals of proclamations of the President and Executive or-20ders shall be permanently retained by the Administration 21 as part of the National Archives of the United States. The 22 Office shall transmit to the Government Publishing Office, 23 as provided by this chapter, each document required or 24 authorized to be published by section 1505 of this title. Every Federal agency shall cause to be transmitted for 25

filing the original of all such documents issued, prescribed,
 or promulgated by the agency.".

3 (d) FEDERAL REGISTER AMENDMENT.—Section
4 1504 of title 44, United States Code, is amended to read
5 as follows:

## 6 "§ 1504. 'Federal Register'; publishing; contents; dis7 tribution; price

8 "Documents required or authorized to be published 9 by section 1505 of this title shall be published immediately 10 by the Government Publishing Office in a serial publication designated the 'Federal Register'. The Director of the 11 12 Government Publishing Office shall make available the facilities of the Government Publishing Office for the 13 prompt publication of the Federal Register in the manner 14 15 and at the times required by this chapter and the regulations prescribed under it. The contents of the daily issues 16 shall constitute all documents, required or authorized to 17 be published, filed with the Office of the Federal Register 18 up to the time of the day immediately preceding the day 19 of publication fixed by regulations under this chapter. 20 21 There shall be published with each document a copy of 22 the notation, required to be made by section 1503 of this 23 title, of the day and hour when, upon filing with the Of-24 fice, the document was made available for public inspec-25 tion. Distribution shall be made at a time in the morning  $\mathbf{5}$ 

of the day of distribution fixed by regulations prescribed
 under this chapter. The prices to be charged for the Fed eral Register may be fixed by the Administrative Com mittee of the Federal Register established by section 1506
 of this title without reference to the restrictions placed
 upon and fixed for the sale of Government publications
 by sections 1705 and 1708 of this title.".

8 (e) DOCUMENTS TO BE PUBLISHED IN FEDERAL
9 REGISTER.—Section 1505 of title 44, United States Code,
10 is amended—

- 11 (1) in subsection (b)—
- 12 (A) in the heading, by striking "COM13 MENTS" and inserting "NEWS COMMENTARY";
  14 and

15 (B) by striking "comments" and inserting16 "news commentary"; and

17 (2) in subsection (c), in the matter following
18 paragraph (2)—

19 (A) by inserting "telecommunications, the
20 Internet," after "the press, the radio,"; and

(B) by striking "and two duplicate originals or two certified copies" and inserting "document".

(f) ADMINISTRATIVE COMMITTEE OF THE FEDERAL
 REGISTER AMENDMENT.—Section 1506 of title 44,
 United States Code, is amended to read as follows:

4 "§1506. Administrative Committee of the Federal
5 Register; establishment and composition;
6 powers and duties

7 "The Administrative Committee of the Federal Reg-8 ister shall consist of the Archivist of the United States 9 or Acting Archivist, who shall chair the committee, an offi-10 cer of the Department of Justice designated by the Attorney General, and the Director of the Government Pub-11 12 lishing Office or Acting Director of the Government Publishing Office. The Director of the Federal Register shall 13 act as secretary of the committee. The committee shall 14 15 prescribe, with the approval of the President, regulations for carrying out this chapter. The regulations shall provide 16 17 for, among other things—

18 "(1) the documents which shall be authorized
19 under section 1505(b) of this title to be published in
20 the Federal Register;

21 "(2) the manner and form in which the Federal
22 Register shall be published;

23 "(3) the manner of distribution to Members of
24 Congress, officers and employees of the United
25 States, or Federal agency, for official use, and the

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number which shall be available for distribution to
 the public;

3 "(4) the prices to be charged for individual cop4 ies of, and subscriptions to, the Federal Register
5 and any reprints and bound volumes of it;

6 "(5) the manner and form by which the Federal
7 Register may receive information and comments
8 from the public, if practicable and efficient; and

9 "(6) special editions of the Federal Register.".
10 (g) CODE OF FEDERAL REGULATIONS AMEND11 MENT.—Section 1510 of title 44, United States Code, is
12 amended to read as follows:

#### 13 "§ 1510. Code of Federal Regulations

14 "(a) Special Edition for Codification of Agen-15 CY DOCUMENTS.—The Administrative Committee of the Federal Register, with the approval of the President, may 16 require, from time to time as it considers necessary, the 17 18 preparation and publication in a special edition of the Fed-19 eral Register a complete codification of the documents of 20 each agency of the Government having general applica-21 bility and legal effect, issued or promulgated by the agency 22 by publication in the Federal Register or by filing with 23 the Administrative Committee, and which are relied upon 24 by the agency as authority for, or are invoked or used by it in the discharge of, its activities or functions, and are 25

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in effect as to facts arising on or after dates specified by
 the Administrative Committee.

3 "(b) CODE OF FEDERAL REGULATIONS.—A codifica-4 tion prepared under subsection (a) of this section shall be 5 published and shall be designated as the 'Code of Federal Regulations'. The Administrative Committee shall regu-6 7 late the manner and forms of publishing this codification. "(c) SUPPLEMENTATION, COLLATION, AND REPUBLI-8 9 CATION.—The Administrative Committee shall regulate 10 the supplementation and the collation and republication of the codification with a view to keeping the Code of Fed-11 12 eral Regulations as current as practicable. Each unit of 13 codification shall be supplemented and republished at least once each calendar year. The Office of the Federal Reg-14 15 ister may create updates of each unit of codification from time to time and make the same available electronically 16 or may provide public access using an electronic edition 17 that allows a user to select a specific date and retrieve 18 the version of the codification in effect as of that date. 19 20 "(d) PREPARATION AND PUBLICATION BY THE FED-21 ERAL REGISTER.—The Office of the Federal Register 22 shall prepare and publish the codifications, supplements, 23 collations, and user aids authorized by this section.

24 "(e) PRIMA FACIE EVIDENCE.—The codified docu-25 ments of the several agencies published in the Code of

Federal Regulations under this section, as amended by
 documents subsequently filed with the Office and pub lished in the daily issues of the Federal Register, shall
 be prima facie evidence of the text of the documents and
 of the fact that they are in effect on and after the date
 of publication.

7 "(f) REGULATIONS.—The Administrative Committee,
8 with approval of the President, shall issue regulations for
9 carrying out this section.

"(g) EXCEPTION.—This section does not require
codification of the text of Presidential documents published and periodically compiled in supplements to title 3
of the Code of Federal Regulations.".

(h) TECHNICAL AND CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—
The table of sections for chapter 15 of title 44, United
States Code, is amended by striking the items related to
sections 1502, 1503, and 1504 and inserting the following:
"1502. Custody and publishing of Federal documents; appointment of Director.
"1503. Filing documents with Office; notation of time; public inspection; transmission for publishing.
"1504. 'Federal Register'; publishing; contents; distribution; price.''.
