A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to prohibit the collection of a health care copayment by the Secretary of Veterans Affairs from a veteran who is a member of an Indian tribe. 3

2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4	This Act may be cited as the "Native American Vet-
5	eran Parity in Access to Care Today Act" or "Native Amer-
6	ican PACT Act".
7	SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON COLLECTION OF A HEALTH CARE
8	COPAYMENT BY THE SECRETARY OF VET-
9	ERANS AFFAIRS FROM A VETERAN WHO IS A
10	MEMBER OF AN INDIAN TRIBE.
11	(a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1730A of title 38, United
12	States Code, is amended—
13	(1) in the heading, by striking "catastroph-
14	ically disabled" and inserting "certain";
15	(2) by inserting "(a) PROHIBITION.—" before
16	"Notwithstanding";
17	(3) by striking "a veteran who is catastroph-
18	ically disabled, as defined by the Secretary," and in-
19	serting "a covered veteran"; and
20	(4) by adding at the end the following new sub-
21	section:
22	"(b) Covered Veteran Defined.—In this section,
23	the term 'covered veteran' means a veteran who—
24	"(1) is catastrophically disabled, as defined by
25	the Secretary; or

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"(2) is an Indian or urban Indian, as those
 terms are defined in section 4 of the Indian Health
 Care Improvement Act (Public Law 94-437; 25
 U.S.C. 1603).".
 (b) TECHNICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections at
 the beginning of chapter 17 of such title is amended by
 striking the item relating to section 1730A and inserting

8 the following:

"1730A. Prohibition on collection of copayments from certain veterans.".

9 (c) DELAYED EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments
10 made by this section shall take effect on the day that is
11 one year after the date of the enactment of this Act.
