A BILL

To modify the boundary of the Rocky Mountain National
Park, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Rocky Mountain Na-
5 tional Park Boundary Modification Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.**

7 In this Act:

8 (1) MAP.—The term “map” means the map en-
9 titled “Rocky Mountain National Park Proposed
10 Boundary Revision”, numbered 121/154,327, and
11 dated June 2019.

12 (2) NON-FEDERAL LAND.—The term “non-Fed-
13 eral land” means the approximately 40 acres of non-
14 Federal land depicted as “TR 05–133” on the map.

15 (3) SECRETARY.—The term “Secretary” means
16 the Secretary of the Interior.

17 **SEC. 3. ROCKY MOUNTAIN NATIONAL PARK BOUNDARY**
18 **MODIFICATION.**

19 (a) LAND ACQUISITION.—The Secretary may ac-
20 quire, by donation, the non-Federal land for inclusion in
21 the Rocky Mountain National Park.

22 (b) BOUNDARY MODIFICATION.—On acquisition of
23 the non-Federal land under subsection (a), the Secretary
24 shall—

1 (1) modify the boundary of the Rocky Mountain
2 National Park to include the acquisition; and

3 (2) administer the acquired land as part of the
4 Rocky Mountain National Park, in accordance with
5 applicable laws.

6 (c) AVAILABILITY OF MAP.—The map shall be on file
7 and available for public inspection in appropriate offices
8 of the National Park Service.
