**A BILL**

To amend the Small Business Act and the CARES Act to extend the covered period for the paycheck protection program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “PPP Extension Act  
5 of 2021”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF COVERED PERIOD FOR PAYCHECK**  
2 **PROTECTION PROGRAM.**

3 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Section 7(a)(36)(A)(iii) of the  
4 Small Business Act (15 U.S.C. 636(a)(36)(A)(iii)) is  
5 amended by striking “March 31, 2021” and inserting  
6 “June 30, 2021”.

7 (b) **FUNDING.**—Section 1102(b)(1) of the CARES  
8 Act (Public Law 116–136), as amended by section 323  
9 of the Economic Aid to Hard-Hit Small Businesses, Non-  
10 profits, and Venues Act (Public Law 116–260), is amend-  
11 ed by striking “March 31, 2021” and inserting “June 30,  
12 2021”.

13 (c) **RESTRICTION.**—From June 1, 2021, through  
14 June 30, 2021, the Administrator of the Small Business  
15 Administration shall not accept new lender applications  
16 for loans under paragraph (36) or (37) of section 7(a)  
17 of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C. 636(a)) and shall  
18 only process such lender applications that have been sub-  
19 mitted to the Administrator before June 1, 2021.
