To direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to make all fact sheets of the Department of Veterans Affairs available in English, Spanish, and Tagalog, and other commonly spoken languages, and for other purposes.

SHORT TITLE.** This Act may be cited as the "Veterans and Family 4 5 Information Act". SEC. 2. FACT SHEETS. 6 7 (a) LANGUAGES.—The Secretary of Veterans Affairs 8 shall make available versions of all fact sheets of the De-9 partment of Veterans Affairs in— 10 (1) English; 11 (2) Spanish; 12 (3) Tagalog; and 13 (4) each of the 10 most commonly spoken lan-14 guages, other than English, in the United States

17 (b) WEBSITE.—The Secretary of Veterans Affairs 18 shall establish and maintain a publicly available website of the Department of Veterans Affairs that contains links 19 to all fact sheets of the Veterans Benefits Administration, 20 21 Veterans Health Administration, and of the National 22 Cemetery Administration. The website shall be accessible 23 by a clearly labeled hyperlink on the homepage of the De-24 partment.

(c) REPORT.—Not later than 180 days after the date
