A BILL

To modify eligibility requirements for certain hazard mitigation assistance programs, and for other purposes. 3

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 2 3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.** 4 This Act may be cited as the "Hazard Eligibility and 5 Local Projects Act". SEC. 2. AUTHORITY TO BEGIN IMPLEMENTATION OF AC-6 7 **QUISITION OR RELOCATION PROJECTS.** 8 (a) ELIGIBILITY FOR ASSISTANCE FOR INITIATED 9 PROJECTS.— 10 (1) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other 11 provision of law, an entity seeking assistance under 12 a hazard mitigation assistance program shall be eli-13 gible to receive such assistance for a covered project 14 if the entity— 15 (A) complies with all other eligibility re-16 quirements of the hazard mitigation assistance 17 program for acquisition or relocation projects, 18 including extinguishing all incompatible encum-19 brances; and 20 (B) complies with all Federal requirements 21 for the project. 22 (2) COSTS INCURRED.—An entity seeking as-23 sistance under a hazard mitigation assistance pro-24 gram shall be responsible for any project costs in-25 curred by the entity for a covered project if the cov4

1	ered project is not awarded, or is determined to be
2	ineligible for, assistance.
3	(b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section, the following defi-
4	nitions apply:
5	(1) COVERED PROJECT.—The term "covered
6	project'' means—
7	(A) an acquisition or relocation project for
8	which an entity began implementation prior to
9	grant award under a hazard mitigation assist-
10	ance program; and
11	(B) a project for which an entity initiated
12	planning or construction before or after re-
13	questing assistance for the project under a haz-
14	ard mitigation assistance program qualifying
15	for a categorical exemption under the National
16	Environmental Policy Act.
17	(2) HAZARD MITIGATION ASSISTANCE PRO-
18	GRAM.—The term "hazard mitigation assistance
19	program" means—
20	(A) the predisaster hazard mitigation
21	grant program authorized under section 203 of
22	the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and
23	Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5133);
24	(B) the hazard mitigation grant program
25	authorized under section 404 of the Robert T.

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1		Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assist-
2		ance Act (42 U.S.C. 5170c); and
3		(C) the flood mitigation assistance pro-
4		gram authorized under section 1366 of the Na-
5		tional Flood Insurance Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C.
6		4104c).
7	(e)	APPLICABILITY.—This section shall apply to
8	funds app	propriated on or after the date of enactment of
9	this Act.
