3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This resolution may be cited as the "Fiscal State of5 the Nation Resolution".

6 SEC. 2. ANNUAL JOINT HEARING OF BUDGET COMMITTEES 7 TO RECEIVE A PRESENTATION BY THE COMP8 TROLLER GENERAL.

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 45 days (excluding 10 Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays) after the date on which 11 the Secretary of the Treasury submits to Congress the au-12 dited financial statement required under paragraph (1) of section 331(e) of title 31, United States Code, on a date 13 14 agreed upon by the chairs of the Committees on the Budget of the House of Representatives and the Senate (here-15 after referred to as the "Budget Committees") and the 16 17 Comptroller General of the United States, the Budget Committees shall hold a joint hearing (hereafter referred 18 to as the "Joint Hearing") to receive a presentation from 19 20 the Comptroller General reviewing the findings of the audit required under paragraph (2) of such section and 21 providing, with respect to the information included by the 22

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Secretary in the report accompanying such audited finan cial statement, an analysis of the financial position and
 condition of the Federal Government, including financial
 measures (such as the net operating cost, income, budget
 deficits, or budget surpluses) and sustainability measures
 (such as the long-term fiscal projection or social insurance
 projection) described in such report.

8 (b) PRESENTATION OF STATEMENT IN ACCORDANCE 9 WITH GAO STRATEGIES AND MEANS.—The Comptroller 10 General of the United States shall ensure that the presentation at the Joint Hearing is made in accordance with 11 12 the Strategies and Means of the Government Accountability Office, so that the presentation will provide profes-13 sional, objective, fact-based, nonpartisan, nonideological, 14 15 fair, and balanced information to the members attending the Joint Hearing. 16

17 (c) RULES APPLICABLE TO JOINT HEARING.—

18 (1) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided in para19 graphs (2) and (3), the Joint Hearing shall be sub20 ject to rules agreed to by the chairs of the Budget
21 Committees.

(2) OPEN HEARING.—The Joint Hearing shall
be open to the public, including to radio, television,
and still photography coverage.

(3) ATTENDANCE.—The Joint Hearing shall
 accommodate non-participatory attendance by any
 Senator and any Member of the House of Represent atives, including any Delegate or Resident Commis sioner to the Congress.

6 (d) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The requirement under sub7 section (a) shall apply with respect to any audited finan8 cial statement submitted on or after the date of the enact9 ment of this resolution.
