A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to furnish seasonal influenza vaccines to certain individuals, and for other purposes. 3

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. AUTHORITY OF SECRETARY OF VETERANS AF-
4	FAIRS TO FURNISH SEASONAL INFLUENZA
5	VACCINES TO CERTAIN INDIVIDUALS NOT EN-
6	ROLLED IN PATIENT ENROLLMENT SYSTEM
7	OF DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS.
8	Section 2 of the SAVE LIVES Act (Public Law 117–
9	4; 38 U.S.C. 1701 note) is amended—
10	(1) by striking "a vaccine for COVID-19" each
11	place it appears and inserting "a vaccine for
12	COVID–19, a seasonal influenza vaccine, or both";
13	(2) in subsection (b)—
14	(A) in the matter preceding paragraph (1),
15	by inserting "and seasonal influenza vaccines"
16	after "vaccines for COVID–19"; and
17	(B) in paragraph (2), by inserting ", sea-
18	sonal influenza vaccines, or both" after "vaccines
19	for COVID-19";
20	(3) in subsection (d), by striking "VACCINE AL-
21	LOCATION" in the heading and inserting "COVID-19
22	VACCINE ALLOCATION";
23	(4) by redesignating subsection (e) as subsection
24	<i>(f)</i> ;

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1	(5) by inserting after subsection (d) the following
2	new subsection (e):
3	"(e) Limitation on Furnishing Seasonal Influ-
4	ENZA VACCINE.—A seasonal influenza vaccine may not be
5	furnished under this section after April 29, 2022.";
6	(6) in subsection (f), as so redesignated—
7	(A) by redesignating paragraph (6) as
8	paragraph (7); and
9	(B) by inserting after paragraph (5) the fol-
10	lowing new paragraph:
11	"(6) Seasonal influenza vaccine.—The term
12	'seasonal influenza vaccine' means any product that
13	is—
14	"(A) approved by the Food and Drug Ad-
15	ministration;
16	``(B) commercially available; and
17	(C) recommended by the Centers for Dis-
18	ease Control and Prevention for the prevention of
19	influenza in a particular season."; and
20	(7) in the section heading by striking " VAC-
21	CINE" and inserting "AND INFLUENZA VAC-
22	CINES".
