A BILL

To provide for an online repository for certain reporting requirements for recipients of Federal disaster assistance, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Post-Disaster Assist-5 ance Online Accountability Act".

6 SEC. 2. SUBPAGE FOR TRANSPARENCY OF DISASTER AS7 SISTANCE.

8 (a) Establishment of Repository for Report-9 ING REQUIREMENTS.—The Director of the Office of Man-10 agement and Budget, in consultation with the Secretary of the Treasury and the head of each covered Federal 11 12 agency, shall establish a subpage within the website estab-13 lished under section 2 of the Federal Funding Accountability and Transparency Act of 2006 (31 U.S.C. 6101 14 15 note) to publish the information required to be made available to the public under this section. 16

17 (b) SUBMISSION OF INFORMATION BY FEDERAL AGENCIES.—Not later than 30 days after the end of a 18 19 calendar quarter, each covered Federal agency that made 20disaster assistance available to an eligible recipient during 21 such quarter shall, in coordination with the Director of 22 the Office of Management and Budget, make available to 23 the public on the subpage established under subsection (a) the information described in subsection (c), and ensure 24 25 that any data asset of the agency is machine-readable.

1	(c) INFORMATION REQUIRED.—The information de-
2	scribed in this subsection is, with respect to disaster as-
3	sistance provided by the covered Federal agency—
4	(1) the total amount of disaster assistance pro-
5	vided by the agency during such quarter;
6	(2) the amount of disaster assistance provided
7	by the agency that was expended or obligated to
8	projects or activities; and
9	(3) a detailed list of all projects or activities for
10	which disaster assistance dispersed by the agency
11	was expended, obligated, or used, including—
12	(A) the name of the project or activity;
13	(B) a description of the project or activity;
14	(C) an evaluation of the completion status
15	of the project or activity;
16	(D) any award identification number as-
17	signed to the project;
18	(E) the Catalog for Disaster Assistance
19	number assigned by the Federal Emergency
20	Management Agency;
21	(F) the location of the project, including
22	ZIP codes; and
23	(G) any reporting requirement information
24	being collected by a covered Federal agency

with respect to that agency's disaster assist ance.

3 (d) GUIDANCE.—Each covered Federal agency, in co4 ordination with the Director of the Office of Management
5 and Budget and the Secretary of the Treasury, shall issue
6 such guidance as is necessary to meet the requirements
7 of this Act.

8 (e) AGREEMENT WITH PRIVATE ENTITY.—The Di-9 rector, if necessary for purposes of transparency, may 10 enter into an agreement with a private entity, including 11 a nonprofit organization, to develop the subpage required 12 under this section.

13 SEC. 3. DEFINITIONS.

14 In this Act, the following definitions apply:

15 (1) COVERED FEDERAL AGENCY.—The term
16 "covered Federal agency" means—

17 (A) any agency providing assistance under
18 the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and
19 Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5121 et
20 seq.);

21 (B) the Small Business Administration;22 and

23 (C) the Department of Housing and Urban24 Development.

1	(2) DISASTER ASSISTANCE.—The term "dis-
2	aster assistance" means any funds that are made
3	available by the Federal Government in response to
4	a specified natural disaster, including—
5	(A) any assistance provided by the Admin-
6	istrator of the Small Business Administration
7	as a result of a disaster declared under section
8	7(b) of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C.
9	636(b));
10	(B) any assistance provided by the Sec-
11	retary of Housing and Urban Development
12	for—
13	(i) activities authorized under title I
14	of the Housing and Community Develop-
15	ment Act of 1974 (42 U.S.C. 5301 et seq.)
16	related to disaster relief, long-term recov-
17	ery, restoration of infrastructure and hous-
18	ing, and economic revitalization in the
19	most impacted and distressed areas result-
20	ing from a major disaster declared pursu-
21	ant to the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Re-
22	lief and Emergency Assistance Act (42
23	U.S.C. 5121 et seq.); and
24	(ii) flood insurance coverage provided
25	under the National Flood Insurance Pro-

1	gram pursuant to the National Flood In-
2	surance Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 4001 et
3	seq.); and
4	(C) any assistance provided under the Rob-
5	ert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency
6	Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5121 et seq.).
7	(3) ELIGIBLE RECIPIENT.—The term "eligible
8	recipient"—
9	(A) means any entity that receives disaster
10	assistance directly from the Federal Govern-
11	ment (including disaster assistance received
12	through grant, loan, or contract) other than an
13	individual; and
14	(B) includes a State that receives disaster
15	assistance.
16	(4) Specified Natural Disaster.—The term
17	"specified natural disaster" means—
18	(A) a fire on public or private forest land
19	or grassland described in section 420 of the
20	Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emer-
21	gency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5187);
22	(B) a major disaster declared by the Presi-
23	dent under section 401 of such Act (42 U.S.C.
24	5170);

1	(C) an emergency declared by the Presi-
2	dent under section 501 of such Act (42 U.S.C.
3	5191); and
4	(D) any other natural disaster for which a
5	disaster declaration is made by the Federal
6	Government.
