## A BILL

To require certain civil penalties to be transferred to a fund through which amounts are made available for the Gabriella Miller Kids First Pediatric Research Program at the National Institutes of Health, and for other purposes.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4        This Act may be cited as the “Gabriella Miller Kids  
5 First Research Act 2.0”.

6 **SEC. 2. FUNDING FOR THE PEDIATRIC RESEARCH INITIA-**  
7 **TIVE.**

8        (a) PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICE ACT.—The Public  
9 Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 201 et seq.) is amended—

10            (1) in section 402A(a)(2) (42 U.S.C.  
11 282a(a)(2))—

12                    (A) in the heading—

13                            (i) by striking “10-YEAR”; and

14                            (ii) by striking “THROUGH COMMON  
15 FUND”;

16                    (B) by striking “to the Common Fund”  
17 and inserting “to the Division of Program Co-  
18 ordination, Planning, and Strategic Initiatives”;

19                    (C) by striking “10-Year”;

20                    (D) by striking “and reserved under sub-  
21 section (c)(1)(B)(i) of this section”; and

22                    (E) by inserting before the period the fol-  
23 lowing: “, and \$25,000,000 for each of fiscal  
24 years 2023 through 2027”;

1 (2) in each of paragraphs (1)(A) and (2)(C) of  
2 section 402A(c) (42 U.S.C. 282a(c)), by striking  
3 “section 402(b)(7)(B)” and inserting “section  
4 402(b)(7)(B)(i)”; and

5 (3) in section 402(b)(7)(B)(ii) (42 U.S.C.  
6 282(b)(7)(B)(ii)), by striking “the Common Fund”  
7 and inserting “the Division of Program Coordina-  
8 tion, Planning, and Strategic Initiatives”.

9 (b) INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1986.—Section  
10 9008(i)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is  
11 amended by striking “10-Year”.

12 **SEC. 3. COORDINATION OF NIH FUNDING FOR PEDIATRIC**  
13 **RESEARCH.**

14 (a) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the sense of the Con-  
15 gress that the Director of the National Institutes of  
16 Health should continue to oversee and coordinate research  
17 that is conducted or supported by the National Institutes  
18 of Health for research on pediatric cancer and other pedi-  
19 atric diseases and conditions, including through the Pedi-  
20 atric Research Initiative Fund.

21 (b) AVOIDING DUPLICATION.—Section  
22 402(b)(7)(B)(ii) of the Public Health Service Act (42  
23 U.S.C. 282(b)(7)(B)(ii)) is amended by inserting “and  
24 shall prioritize, as appropriate, such pediatric research

1 that does not duplicate existing research activities of the  
2 National Institutes of Health” before “; and”.

3 **SEC. 4. REPORT ON PROGRESS AND INVESTMENTS IN PEDI-**  
4 **ATRIC RESEARCH.**

5 Not later than 5 years after the date of the enact-  
6 ment of this Act, the Secretary of Health and Human  
7 Services shall submit to the appropriate committees of  
8 Congress a report that—

9 (1) details pediatric research projects and ini-  
10 tiatives receiving funds allocated pursuant to section  
11 402(b)(7)(B)(ii) of the Public Health Service Act  
12 (42 U.S.C. 282(b)(7)(B)(ii)); and

13 (2) summarizes advancements made in pediatric  
14 research with funds allocated pursuant to section  
15 402(b)(7)(B)(ii) of the Public Health Service Act  
16 (42 U.S.C. 282(b)(7)(B)(ii)).

Amend the title so as to read: “A bill to extend the  
Gabriella Miller Kids First Pediatric Research Program  
at the National Institutes of Health, and for other pur-  
poses.”.
