RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the Senate amendment to the bill (H.R. 6833) to amend title XXVII of the Public Health Service Act, the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, and the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 to establish requirements with respect to cost-sharing for certain insulin products, and for other purposes; and providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 8987) to amend the Justice for United States Victims of State $\mathbf{2}$

Sponsored Terrorism Act to authorize appropriations for catch-up payments from the United States Victims of State Sponsored Terrorism Fund.

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it 2 shall be in order to take from the Speaker's table the bill 3 (H.R. 6833) to amend title XXVII of the Public Health 4 Service Act, the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, and the 5 Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 to establish requirements with respect to cost-sharing for cer-6 7 tain insulin products, and for other purposes, with the 8 Senate amendment thereto, and to consider in the House, 9 without intervention of any point of order, a motion of-10 fered by the chair of the Committee on Appropriations or her designee that the House concur in the Senate amend-11 ment. The Senate amendment and the motion shall be 12 13 considered as read. The motion shall be debatable for one 14 hour equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of the Committee on Appropriations 15 or their respective designees. The previous question shall 16 be considered as ordered on the motion to its adoption 17 18 without intervening motion.

SEC. 2. Upon adoption of this resolution it shall be
in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 8987)
to amend the Justice for United States Victims of State
Sponsored Terrorism Act to authorize appropriations for
catch-up payments from the United States Victims of

State Sponsored Terrorism Fund. All points of order 1 2 against consideration of the bill are waived. An amendment in the nature of a substitute consisting of the text 3 4 of Rules Committee Print 117-68 shall be considered as 5 adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be considered as read. 6 All points of order against provisions in the bill, as amend-7 ed, are waived. The previous question shall be considered 8 as ordered on the bill, as amended, and on any further 9 amendment thereto, to final passage without intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and 10 11 controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of 12 the Committee on the Judiciary or their respective designees; and (2) one motion to recommit. 13
