## **AN ACT**

- To amend the National Trails System Act to designate the Butterfield Overland National Historic Trail, and for other purposes.
  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
2	This Act may be cited as the "Butterfield Overland
3	National Historic Trail Designation Act".
4	SEC. 2. DESIGNATION OF THE BUTTERFIELD OVERLAND
5	NATIONAL HISTORIC TRAIL.
6	Section 5(a) of the National Trails System Act (16
7	U.S.C. 1244(a)) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
8	lowing:
9	"(31) Butterfield overland national his-
10	TORIC TRAIL.—
11	"(A) IN GENERAL.—The Butterfield Over-
12	land National Historic Trail, a trail of approxi-
13	mately 3,292 miles following the route operated
14	by the Butterfield Overland Mail Company,
15	known as the 'Ox-Bow Route', to transport mail
16	and passengers between the eastern termini of
17	St. Louis, Missouri, and Memphis, Tennessee,
18	and extending westward through the States of
19	Arkansas, Oklahoma, Texas, New Mexico, and
20	Arizona, to the western terminus of San Fran-
21	cisco, California, as generally depicted on the
22	maps numbered 1 through 15, entitled 'Study
23	Route Maps', and contained in the report pre-
24	pared by the National Park Service entitled
25	'Butterfield Overland Trail National Historical

1	Trail Special Resource Study' and dated May
2	2018.
3	"(B) MAPS.—The maps described in sub-
4	paragraph (A) shall be on file and available for
5	public inspection in the appropriate offices of
6	the National Park Service.
7	"(C) Administration.—The trail estab-
8	lished by subparagraph (A) shall be adminis-
9	tered by the Secretary of the Interior.
10	"(D) LAND ACQUISITION.—The United
11	States shall not acquire for the trail established
12	by subparagraph (A) any land or interest in
13	land outside of the exterior boundary of any
14	federally administered area without the consent
15	of the owner of the land or interest in land.
16	"(E) No buffer zone created.—
17	"(i) IN GENERAL.—Nothing in this
18	paragraph, the acquisition of land or an in-
19	terest in land authorized by this para-
20	graph, or any management plan for the
21	Butterfield Overland National Historic
22	Trail creates a buffer zone outside of the
23	Butterfield Overland National Historic
24	Trail.

- 1 "(ii) OUTSIDE ACTIVITIES.—The fact that an activity or use on land outside the 2 3 Butterfield Overland National Historic 4 Trail can be seen, heard, or detected from land or an interest in land acquired for the 5 6 Butterfield Overland National Historic 7 Trail shall not preclude, limit, control, reg-8 ulate, or determine the conduct or manage-9 ment of the activity or use. "(F) EFFECT ON ENERGY DEVELOPMENT, 10
- 11 PRODUCTION, OR TRANSMISSION.—Nothing in 12 this paragraph, the acquisition of land or an in-13 terest in land authorized by this paragraph, or 14 any management plan for the Butterfield Over-15 land National Historic Trail shall prohibit, 16 hinder, or disrupt the development, production, 17 or transmission of energy.
- 18 "(G) NO EMINENT DOMAIN OR CONDEMNA19 TION.—In carrying out this paragraph, the Sec-

retary of the Interior may not use eminent do main or condemnation.".
