CONTAINER AERIAL FIREFIGHTING **SYSTEM** 7 (CAFFS). 8 (a) EVALUATION.—Not later than 90 days after the 9 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Agri-10 culture and the Secretary of the Interior, in consultation with the National Interagency Aviation Committee and the 11 Interagency Airtanker Board, shall jointly conduct an eval-12 13 uation of the container aerial firefighting system to assess the use of such system to mitigate and suppress wildfires. 14 15 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 120 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Agriculture 16 and the Secretary of the Interior, in consultation with the 17 National Interagency Aviation Committee and the Inter-18 agency Airtanker Board, shall jointly submit to the appro-19 20 priate committees a report that includes the results of the
