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A BILL

To amend the Homeland Security Act of 2002 relating to authority of U.S. Customs and Border Protection to consolidate, modify, or reorganize Customs revenue functions.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. AUTHORITY OF U.S. CUSTOMS AND BORDER
4	PROTECTION TO CONSOLIDATE, MODIFY, OR
5	REORGANIZE CUSTOMS REVENUE FUNC-
6	TIONS.
7	(a) In General.—Section 412 of the Homeland Secu-
8	rity Act of 2002 (6 U.S.C. 212(b)) is amended—
9	(1) in subsection (b)—
10	(A) in paragraph (1)—
11	(i) by striking "consolidate, dis-
12	continue," and inserting "discontinue"; and
13	(ii) by inserting after "reduce the staff-
14	ing level" the following: "below the optimal
15	staffing level determined in the most recent
16	Resource Allocation Model required by sec-
17	tion 301(h) of the Customs Procedural Re-
18	form and Simplification Act of 1978 (19
19	U.S.C. 2075(h))"; and
20	(B) in paragraph (2), by inserting ", Na-
21	tional Account Managers, International Trade
22	Analysts" after "Financial Systems Specialists";

24	(2) by adding at the end the following:

1	"(d) Authority to Consolidate, Modify, or Re-
2	ORGANIZE CUSTOMS REVENUE FUNCTIONS.—
3	"(1) In general.—The Commissioner of U.S.
4	Customs and Border Protection may, subject to sub-
5	section (b), consolidate, modify, or reorganize customs
6	revenue functions delegated to the Commissioner
7	under subsection (a), including by adding such func-
8	tions to existing positions or establishing new or
9	modifying existing job series, grades, titles, or classi-
10	fications for personnel, and associated support staff,
11	performing such functions.
12	"(2) Position classification standards.— At
13	the request of the Commissioner, the Director of the
14	Office of Personnel Management shall establish new
15	position classification standards for any new posi-
16	tions established by the Commissioner under para-
17	graph (1).".
18	(b) Technical Correction.—Section 412(a)(1) of
19	the Homeland Security Act of 2002 (6 U.S.C. 212(a)(1))
20	is amended by striking "403(a)(1)" and inserting "403(1)".
