

Suspend the Rules and Pass the Bill, H.R. 5862, With an Amendment

(The amendment strikes all after the enacting clause and inserts a new text)

To amend the Homeland Security Act of 2002 relating to authority of U.S. Customs and Border Protection to consolidate, modify, or reorganize Customs revenue functions.

A BILL

To amend the Homeland Security Act of 2002 relating to authority of U.S. Customs and Border Protection to consolidate, modify, or reorganize Customs revenue functions.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. AUTHORITY OF U.S. CUSTOMS AND BORDER**
2 **PROTECTION TO CONSOLIDATE, MODIFY, OR**
3 **REORGANIZE CUSTOMS REVENUE FUNC-**
4 **TIONS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 412 of the Homeland Se-
6 curity Act of 2002 (6 U.S.C. 212(b)) is amended—

7 (1) in subsection (b)—

8 (A) in paragraph (1)—

9 (i) by striking “consolidate, dis-
10 continue,” and inserting “discontinue”;
11 and

12 (ii) by inserting after “reduce the
13 staffing level” the following: “below the op-
14 timal staffing level determined in the most
15 recent Resource Allocation Model required
16 by section 301(h) of the Customs Proce-
17 dural Reform and Simplification Act of
18 1978 (19 U.S.C. 2075(h))”; and

19 (B) in paragraph (2), by inserting “, Na-
20 tional Account Managers, International Trade
21 Analysts” after “Financial Systems Special-
22 ists”; and

23 (2) by adding at the end the following:

24 “(d) AUTHORITY TO CONSOLIDATE, MODIFY, OR RE-
25 ORGANIZE CUSTOMS REVENUE FUNCTIONS.—

1 “(1) IN GENERAL.—The Commissioner of U.S.
2 Customs and Border Protection may, subject to sub-
3 section (b), consolidate, modify, or reorganize cus-
4 toms revenue functions delegated to the Commis-
5 sioner under subsection (a), including by adding
6 such functions to existing positions or establishing
7 new or modifying existing job series, grades, titles,
8 or classifications for personnel, and associated sup-
9 port staff, performing such functions, in consultation
10 with the Office of Personnel Management.

11 “(2) POSITION CLASSIFICATION STANDARDS.—
12 At the request of the Commissioner, the Director of
13 the Office of Personnel Management shall establish
14 new position classification standards for any new po-
15 sitions established by the Commissioner under para-
16 graph (1).”.

17 (b) TECHNICAL CORRECTION.—Section 412(a)(1) of
18 the Homeland Security Act of 2002 (6 U.S.C. 212(a)(1))
19 is amended by striking “403(a)(1)” and inserting
20 “403(1)”.
