A BILL

To direct the Comptroller General of the United States to conduct a review on the Public Buildings Service, and for other purposes.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4	This Act may be cited as the "Public Buildings Ac-
5	countability Act of 2023".
6	SEC. 2. REPORT ON PUBLIC BUILDINGS SERVICE.
7	Not later than 1 year after the date of enactment
8	of this Act, the Comptroller General of the United States
9	shall conduct a review of the Public Buildings Service and
10	submit to the Committee on Transportation and Infra-
11	structure of the House of Representatives and the Com-
12	mittee on Environment and Public Works of the Senate
13	a report containing the results of such review, including—
14	(1) a review of the administration and manage-
15	ment of all Public Buildings Service real estate pro-
16	grams and activities, including—
17	(A) a review and accounting of the number
18	of employees and contract workers, including
19	functions and the sources of funding (for exam-
20	ple building operations, reimbursable work,
21	project-specific funding) categorized by region
22	and organizational, management, and oversight
23	structure within the Public Building Service, in-
24	cluding identification of components, programs,
25	and reporting structures;

1	(B) an accounting of in-person attendance
2	by employee category and function;
3	(C) an analysis, trends, and comparisons
4	of staffing numbers and associated costs and
5	other administrative costs over the 10 years
6	preceding the review; and
7	(D) an analysis of the effectiveness of or-
8	ganizational structure, management, and over-
9	sight in carrying out the mission of the Public
10	Buildings Service; and
11	(2) a review of the building operations account
12	of the Federal Buildings Fund established by section
13	592 of title 40, United States Code, including activi-
14	ties and costs associated with conferences, training,
15	and travel and transportation.
