11 "(c) VACANCIES.—(1) Whenever a vacancy in the po-12 sition of Under Secretary for Veterans Economic Oppor-13 tunity and Transition occurs or is anticipated, the Sec-14 retary shall establish a commission to recommend individ-15 uals to the President for appointment to the position.

16 "(2) A commission established under this subsection17 shall be composed of the following members appointed by18 the Secretary:

"(A) Three persons representing education and
training, vocational rehabilitation, employment, real
estate, mortgage finance and related industries, and
survivor benefits activities affected by the Veterans
Economic Opportunity and Transition Administration.

"(B) Two persons representing veterans served
 by the Veterans Economic Opportunity and Transi tion Administration.

4 "(C) Two persons who have experience in the
5 management of private sector benefits programs of
6 similar content and scope to the economic oppor7 tunity and transition programs of the Department.
8 "(D) The Deputy Secretary of Veterans Affairs.
9 "(E) The chairman of the Veterans' Advisory

10 Committee on Education formed under section 369211 of this title.

12 "(F) One person who has held the position of 13 Under Secretary for Veterans Economic Opportunity 14 and Transition, if the Secretary determines that it 15 is desirable for such person to be a member of the 16 commission.

17 "(3) A commission established under this subsection 18 shall recommend at least three individuals for appoint-19 ment to the position of Under Secretary for Veterans Eco-20 nomic Opportunity and Transition. The commission shall 21 submit all recommendations to the Secretary. The Sec-22 retary shall forward the recommendations to the President 23 and the Committees on Veterans' Affairs of the Senate 24 and House of Representatives with any comments the Secretary considers appropriate. Thereafter, the President 25

may request the commission to recommend additional in dividuals for appointment.

3 "(4) The Assistant Secretary or Deputy Assistant
4 Secretary of Veterans Affairs who performs personnel
5 management and labor relations functions shall serve as
6 the executive secretary of a commission established under
7 this subsection.".

#### 12 SEC. 4. TRANSFER OF SERVICES.

13 (a) REPORT TO CONGRESS.—Not later than 180 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary 14 15 of Veterans Affairs shall submit to the Committees on Veterans' Affairs of the Senate and House of Representa-16 17 tives a report on the progress toward establishing the Veterans Economic Opportunity and Transition Administra-18 tion, as established under section 8001 of title 38, United 19 20 States Code, as added by section 2, and the transition of 21 the provision of services to veterans by such Administra-22 tion.

23 (b) CERTIFICATION.—The Secretary of Veterans Af24 fairs may not transfer the function of providing any serv25 ices to veterans to the Veterans Economic Opportunity

and Transition Administration, as established under sec-1 2 tion 8001 of title 38, United States Code, as added by 3 section 2, until the Secretary submits to the Committees 4 on Veterans' Affairs of the Senate and House of Rep-5 resentatives certification that— 6 (1) the transition of the provision of services to 7 such Administration will not negatively affect the 8 provision of such services to veterans; and 9 (2) such services are ready to be transferred. 10 (c) DEADLINE FOR CERTIFICATION.—The Secretary

11 shall submit to the Committees on Veterans' Affairs of
12 the Senate and House of Representatives the certification
13 required by subsection (b)—

14 (1) no earlier than April 1, 2025; and

15 (2) no later than September 1, 2025.

(d) FAILURE TO CERTIFY.—If the Secretary fails to
submit the certification required by subsection (b) by the
date specified in subsection (c)(2), the Secretary shall submit to the Committees on Veterans' Affairs of the Senate
and House of Representatives a report that includes—

(1) the reason why the certification was notmade by such date; and
