## A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to improve the processes to approve programs of education for purposes of the educational assistance programs of the Department of Veterans Affairs, and for other purposes.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. 4 This Act may be cited as the "Veterans Education 5 Transparency and Training Act" or the "VETT Act". 6 SEC. 2. PROCESSES TO APPROVE PROGRAMS OF EDU-7 CATION FOR PURPOSES **OF** THE EDU-8 CATIONAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS OF THE 9 DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS. 10 (a) Limitation of Disapproval of Programs of 11 Education for Failure To Provide Certain Forms.— Section 3679(f)(5) of title 38, United States Code, is amend-12 13 ed— 14 (1) in subparagraph (A), by striking "this para-15 graph" and inserting "this subparagraph"; 16 (2) in subparagraph (B), by striking "this para-17 graph" and inserting "subparagraph (A)"; and 18 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-19 paragraph: 20 "(C) If an educational institution cannot provide to 21 an individual a form under paragraph (1) that contains 22 all of the information required under subparagraph (A) of 23 such paragraph, the educational institution shall provide 24 to such individual, with the form under such paragraph, 25 a notice—

1	"(i) that specifies what such information may be
2	inaccurate or incomplete; and
3	"(ii) that includes, in place of the information
4	that may be inaccurate or incomplete, the best esti-
5	mate available on the date of such notice.".
6	(b) Publication of Information About Training
7	FOR SCHOOL CERTIFYING OFFICIALS.—The Secretary of
8	Veterans Affairs shall establish a website to serve as a cen-
9	tral location for the publication of information about the
10	training that the Department of Veterans Affairs provides
11	for school certifying officials and shall update such informa-
12	tion on a regular basis.

6	"(2)(A) Subject to this paragraph, a commercial driver
7	education program is exempt from paragraph $(1)(B)$ for a
8	branch of an educational institution if the commercial driv-
9	er education program offered at the branch by the edu-
10	cational institution—
11	"(i) is appropriately licensed; and
12	((ii)(I)) the branch is located in a State in which
13	the same commercial driver education program is of-
14	fered by the same educational institution at another
15	branch of that educational institution in the same
16	State that is approved for purposes of this chapter by
17	a State approving agency or the Secretary when act-
18	ing in the role of a State approving agency; or
19	``(II)(aa) the branch is located in a State in
20	which the same commercial driver education program
21	is not offered at another branch of the same edu-
22	cational institution in the same State; and
23	"(bb) the branch has been operating for a period
24	of at least one year using the same curriculum as a
25	commercial driver education program offered by the

educational institution at another location that is ap proved for purposes of this chapter by a State approv ing agency or the Secretary when acting in the role
 of a State approving agency.

5 (B)(i) In order for a commercial driver education program of an educational institution offered at a branch 6 7 described in paragraph (1)(B) to be exempt under subpara-8 graph (A) of this paragraph, the educational institution 9 shall submit to the Secretary each year that paragraph 10 (1)(B) would otherwise apply a report that demonstrates 11 that the curriculum at the new branch is the same as the 12 curriculum at the primary location.

"(ii) Reporting under clause (i) shall be submitted in
accordance with such requirements as the Secretary shall
establish in consultation with the State approving agencies.
"(C)(i) The Secretary may withhold an exemption
under subparagraph (A) for any educational institution or
branch of an educational institution as the Secretary considers appropriate.

"(ii) In making any determination under clause (i),
the Secretary may consult with the Secretary of Transportation on the performance of a provider of a commercial
driver program, including the status of the provider within
the Training Provider Registry of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration when appropriate.

"(D) The Secretary shall submit to the Committees on
 Veterans' Affairs of the Senate and House of Representa tives a notification not later than 30 days after the Sec retary grants an exemption under this paragraph. Such no tification shall identify the educational institution and
 branch of such educational institution granted such exemp tion.".

8 (b) Implementation.—

9 (1) ESTABLISHMENT OF REQUIREMENTS.—Not
10 later than 180 days after the date of the enactment
11 of this Act, the Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall es12 tablish requirements under section 3680A(e)(2)(B)(ii)
13 of such title, as added by subsection (a).

14 (2) RULEMAKING.—In promulgating any rules
15 to carry out paragraph (2) of section 3680A(e) of title
16 38, United States Code, as added by subsection (a),
17 the Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall consult with
18 State approving agencies.

(3) APPLICABILITY.—The amendments made by
subsection (a) shall apply to commercial driver education programs on and after the day that is 180
days after the date on which the Secretary establishes
the requirements under paragraph (1) of this subsection.
