# **A BILL**

To ban the sale of products with a high concentration of sodium nitrite to individuals, and for other purposes.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4        This Act may be cited as the “Youth Poisoning Pro-  
5 tection Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. BANNING OF PRODUCTS CONTAINING A HIGH CON-**  
7 **CENTRATION OF SODIUM NITRITE.**

8        (a) IN GENERAL.—Any consumer product containing  
9 a high concentration of sodium nitrite shall be considered  
10 to be a banned hazardous product under section 8 of the  
11 Consumer Product Safety Act (15 U.S.C. 2057).

12        (b) DEFINITIONS.—For purposes of this section:

13            (1) CONSUMER PRODUCT.—The term “con-  
14 sumer product” has the meaning given that term  
15 under section 3(a)(5) of the Consumer Product  
16 Safety Act (15 U.S.C. 2052(a)(5)).

17            (2) HIGH CONCENTRATION OF SODIUM NI-  
18 TRITE.—The term “high concentration of sodium ni-  
19 trite” means a concentration of 10 or more percent  
20 by weight of sodium nitrite.

21        (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This section shall take effect  
22 90 days after the date of enactment of this Act.
