## A BILL

To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 203 East 6th Street in Lexington, Nebraska, as the “Bill Barrett Post Office Building”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. WILLIAM E. AND ELSIE L. BARRETT POST OF-**

4 **FICE BUILDING.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States

6 Postal Service located at 203 East 6th Street in Lex-

1 ington, Nebraska, shall be known and designated as the  
2 “William E. and Elsie L. Barrett Post Office Building”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-  
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United  
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall  
6 be deemed to be a reference to the “William E. and Elsie  
7 L. Barrett Post Office Building”.

Amend the title so as to read: “A bill to designate  
the facility of the United States Postal Service located at  
203 East 6th Street in Lexington, Nebraska, as the ‘Wil-  
liam E. and Elsie L. Barrett Post Office Building’”.
