## **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Promoting Opportuni5 ties to Widen Electrical Resilience Act of 2025" or the
6 "POWER Act of 2025".

## 1 SEC. 2. ESSENTIAL ASSISTANCE.

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 403 of the Robert T.
3 Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act
4 (42 U.S.C. 5170b) is amended by adding at the end the
5 following:

6 "(e) ELECTRIC UTILITIES.—

"(1) HAZARD MITIGATION ACTIVITIES.—An
electric utility may carry out cost-effective hazard
mitigation activities jointly or otherwise in combination with activities for the restoration of power carried out with assistance provided under this section.

12 "(2) ELIGIBILITY FOR ADDITIONAL ASSIST-13 ANCE.— In any case in which an electric utility fa-14 cility receives assistance under this section for the 15 emergency restoration of power, the receipt of such 16 assistance shall not render such facility ineligible for 17 any hazard mitigation assistance under section 406 18 for which such facility is otherwise eligible.".

(b) APPLICABILITY.—The amendment made by subsection (a) shall only apply to amounts appropriated on
or after the date of enactment of this Act.
