**A BILL**

To recognize the Margaret Woodbury Strong Museum in  
Rochester, New York.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “National Museum of  
5 Play Recognition Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. DESIGNATION OF NATIONAL MUSEUM OF PLAY IN**

7 **ROCHESTER, NEW YORK.**

8 (a) CONGRESSIONAL RECOGNITION.—Congress—

1           (1) recognizes that the Margaret Woodbury  
2           Strong Museum, DBA Strong Museum, located in  
3           Rochester, New York, is the only museum of its kind  
4           that exists for the exclusive purpose of exploring the  
5           ways in which play encourages learning, creativity,  
6           and discovery, and how it illuminates cultural his-  
7           tory; and

8           (2) officially designates the Margaret Woodbury  
9           Strong Museum as the National Museum of Play.

10          (b) EFFECT OF RECOGNITION; DESIGNATION.—The  
11          National Museum of Play recognized in subsection (a) is  
12          not a unit of the National Park System and the designa-  
13          tion under subsection (a) shall not be construed to require  
14          or permit Federal funds to be expended for any purpose  
15          related to the Museum.
