## A BILL

To amend the Federal Credit Union Act to modify the frequency of board of directors meetings, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Credit Union Board
- 5 Modernization Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. FREQUENCY OF BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETINGS.
- 7 Section 113 of the Federal Credit Union Act (12)
- 8 U.S.C. 1761b) is amended—

1	(1) by striking "monthly" each place such term
2	appears;
3	(2) in the matter preceding paragraph (1), by
4	striking "The board of directors" and inserting the
5	following:
6	"(a) In General.—The board of directors";
7	(3) in subsection (a) (as so designated), by
8	striking "shall meet at least once a month and"; and
9	(4) by adding at the end the following:
10	"(b) Meetings.—The board of directors of a Federal
11	credit union shall meet as follows:
12	"(1) With respect to a de novo Federal credit
13	union, not less frequently than monthly during each
14	of the first five years of the existence of such Fed-
15	eral credit union.
16	"(2) Not less than six times annually, with at
17	least one meeting held during each fiscal quarter,
18	with respect to a Federal credit union—
19	"(A) with composite rating of either 1 or
