**RESOLUTION**

Providing for consideration of the Senate amendment to the concurrent resolution (H. Con. Res. 14) establishing the congressional budget for the United States Government for fiscal year 2025 and setting forth the appropriate budgetary levels for fiscal years 2026 through 2034, and for other purposes.

- 1       *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
- 2 shall be in order to take from the Speaker's table the con-
- 3 current resolution (H. Con. Res. 14) establishing the con-

1 gressional budget for the United States Government for  
2 fiscal year 2025 and setting forth the appropriate budg-  
3 etary levels for fiscal years 2026 through 2034, with the  
4 Senate amendment thereto, and to consider in the House,  
5 without intervention of any point of order, a motion of-  
6 fered by the chair of the Committee on the Budget or his  
7 designee that the House concur in the Senate amendment.  
8 The Senate amendment and the motion shall be consid-  
9 ered as read. The motion shall be debatable for one hour  
10 equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking  
11 minority member of the Committee on the Budget or their  
12 respective designees. The previous question shall be con-  
13 sidered as ordered on the motion to adoption without in-  
14 tervening motion.

15       SEC. 2. Each day during the period from April 9,  
16 2025, through September 30, 2025, shall not constitute  
17 a calendar day for purposes of section 202 of the National  
18 Emergencies Act (50 U.S.C. 1622) with respect to a joint  
19 resolution terminating a national emergency declared by  
20 the President on April 2, 2025.
