A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to seek to enter into an agreement with a federally funded research and development center for an assessment of forms that the Secretary sends to claimants for benefits under laws administered by the Secretary, and for other purposes. 3

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. 4 This Act may be cited as the "Simplifying Forms for 5 Veterans Claims Act". SEC. 2. INDEPENDENT ASSESSMENT OF FORMS THAT THE 6 7 SECRETARY OF VETERANS AFFAIRS SENDS 8 TO CLAIMANTS. 9 (a) AGREEMENT.—Not later than 30 days after the 10 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall seek to enter into an agreement with an 11 FFRDC for an assessment of forms that the Secretary sends 12 to claimants. 13 (b) ASSESSMENT.—An FFRDC that enters to an 14 agreement under subsection (a) shall submit to the Sec-15 retary a written assessment, made in consultation with cov-16

17 ered entities, of such forms. The assessment shall include
18 the recommendations of the FFRDC regarding how the Sec19 retary may make such forms clearer to claimants and better
20 organized.

(c) REPORT; IMPLEMENTATION.—Not later than 90
days after the Secretary receives the assessment under subsection (b), the Secretary shall—

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1	(1) submit to the Committees on Veterans' Af-
2	fairs of the Senate and House of Representatives a
3	copy of such assessment; and
4	(2) implement the recommendations in the as-
5	sessment that are in compliance with the laws admin-
6	istered by the Secretary.
7	(d) Deadline for Implementation.—The Secretary
8	shall complete the implementation of such recommendations
9	pursuant to subsection $(c)(2)$ by not later than two years
10	after the date on which the Secretary commences such im-
11	plementation.
12	(e) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:
13	(1) The term "FFRDC" means a federally fund-
14	ed research and development center.
15	(2) The term "covered entities" includes—
16	(A) the Secretary of Veterans Affairs;
17	(B) an expert in laws administered by the
18	Secretary of Veterans Affairs;
19	(C) a veterans service organization recog-
20	nized under section 5902 of title 38, United
21	States Code;
22	(D) an entity that advocates for veterans;
23	and
24	(E) an entity that advocates for survivors of
25	veterans.

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(3) The term "claimant" has the meaning given
 such term in section 5100 of title 38, United States
 Code.
