A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to make certain improvements to the Veterans Readiness and Employment program of Department of Veterans Affairs, and for other purposes.

3	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4	This Act may be cited as the "Veterans Readiness and
5	Employment Program Integrity Act".
6	SEC. 2. APPLICATION REQUIREMENT UNDER VETERANS
7	READINESS AND EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM OF
8	DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS.

18	(1) Review required.—Not later than one year
19	after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Sec-
20	retary of Veterans Affairs shall seek to enter into a
21	contract, with a non-Department entity that has ex-
22	pertise in vocational rehabilitation, pursuant to
23	which the entity shall conduct a review of rehabilita-
24	tion programs (as such term is defined in section
25	3101 of such title) under such chapter.

1	(2) Report.—Not later than one year after the
2	date of such a contract, the entity shall submit to the
3	Secretary a report containing recommendations re-
4	garding how to improve and modernize such rehabili-
5	tation programs.
