Ms. FOXX, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 7148) making further consolidated appropriations for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2026, and for other purposes; providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 7147) making further consolidated appropriations for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2026, and for other purposes; and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after adoption of this reso-
2 lution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule

1 XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee of
2 the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
3 ation of the bill (H.R. 7148) making further consolidated
4 appropriations for the fiscal year ending September 30,
5 2026, and for other purposes. The first reading of the bill
6 shall be dispensed with. All points of order against consid-
7 eration of the bill are waived. General debate shall be con-
8 fined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally di-
9 vided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority
10 member of the Committee on Appropriations or their re-
11 spective designees. After general debate the bill shall be
12 considered for amendment under the five-minute rule. The
13 amendment printed in part A of the report of the Com-
14 mittee on Rules accompanying this resolution shall be con-
15 sidered as adopted in the House and in the Committee
16 of the Whole. The bill, as amended, shall be considered
17 as read. All points of order against provisions in the bill,
18 as amended, are waived. No further amendment to the bill,
19 as amended, shall be in order except those printed in part
20 B of the report of the Committee on Rules. Each such
21 further amendment may be offered only in the order print-
22 ed in the report, may be offered only by a Member des-
23 ignated in the report, shall be considered as read, shall
24 be debatable for the time specified in the report equally
25 divided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent,

1 shall not be subject to amendment, and shall not be sub-
2 ject to a demand for division of the question in the House
3 or in the Committee of the Whole. All points of order
4 against such further amendments are waived. At the con-
5 clusion of consideration of the bill for amendment the
6 Committee shall rise and report the bill, as amended, to
7 the House with such further amendments as may have
8 been adopted. The previous question shall be considered
9 as ordered on the bill, as amended, and on any further
10 amendment thereto to final passage without intervening
11 motion except one motion to recommit.

12 SEC. 2. Upon adoption of this resolution it shall be
13 in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 7147)
14 making further consolidated appropriations for the fiscal
15 year ending September 30, 2026, and for other purposes.
16 All points of order against consideration of the bill are
17 waived. The bill shall be considered as read. All points of
18 order against provisions in the bill are waived. The pre-
19 vious question shall be considered as ordered on the bill
20 and on any amendment thereto to final passage without
21 intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally
22 divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority
23 member of the Committee on Appropriations or their re-
24 spective designees; and (2) one motion to recommit.

1 SEC. 3. The chair of the Committee on Appropriations may insert in the Congressional Record not later than January 23, 2026, such material as he may deem explanatory of H.R. 7148 and H.R. 7147.

5 SEC. 4. The Clerk shall not transmit to the Senate a message that the House has passed H.R. 7148 until 7 H.R. 7147 is passed by the House.

8 SEC. 5. In the engrossment of H.R. 7148, the Clerk shall—

10 (a) add the text of Divisions A, B, and C of H.R. 7006, as passed by the House, as new matter to follow Division D of H.R. 7148, redesignated as Divisions E, F, and G, respectively;

14 (b) add the text of titles I through V of H.R. 7147, as passed by the House, as new matter designated as Division H, to follow the text added pursuant to subsection (a);

18 (c) redesignate Divisions E and F of H.R. 7148 as Divisions I and J, respectively;

20 (d) assign appropriate designations to provisions within the engrossment;

22 (e) conform cross-references and provisions for short titles within the engrossment; and

24 (f) be authorized to make technical corrections, 25 to include corrections in spelling, punctuation, page

1 and line numbering, section numbering, and inser-
2 tion of appropriate headings.

3 SEC. 6. House Resolution 375, as amended by the
4 amendments printed in part C of the report of the Com-
5 mittee on Rules accompanying this resolution, is hereby
6 adopted.
